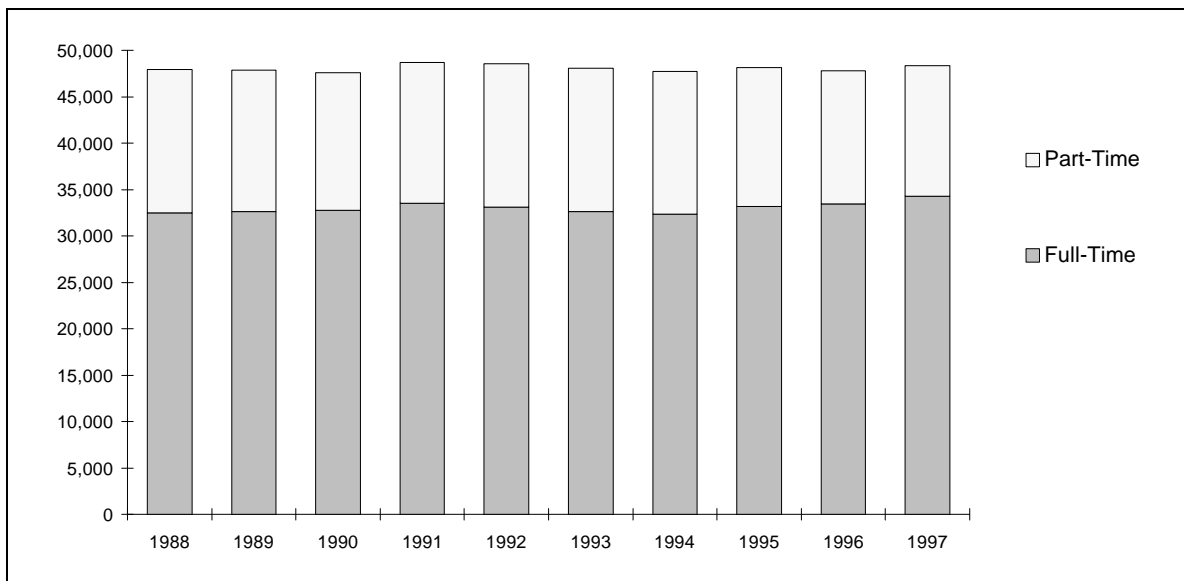

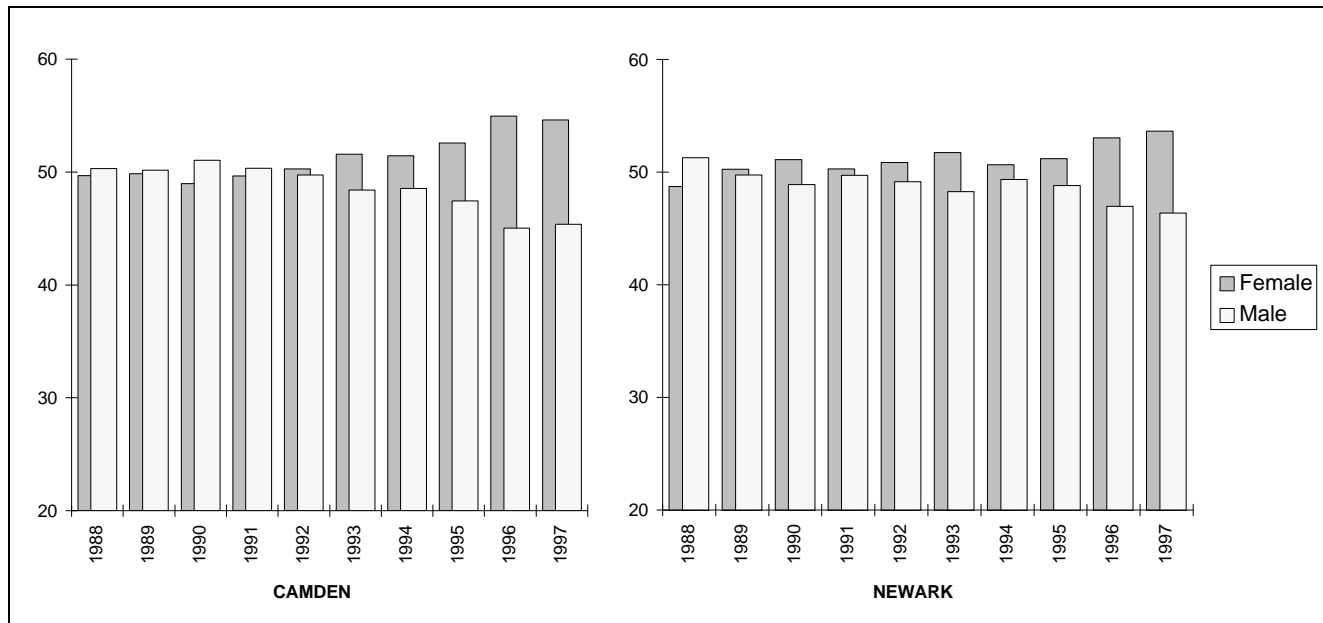

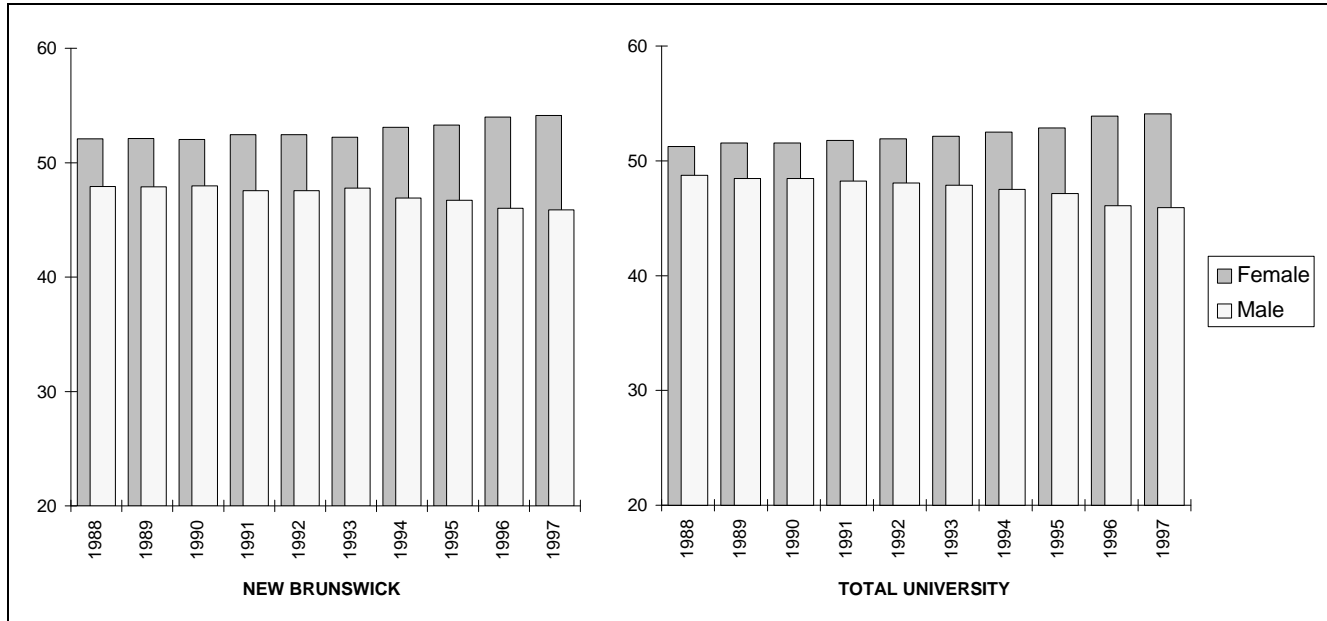
Percent Full-Time Equivalent Enrollment by Gender for Camden Campus and Newark Campus

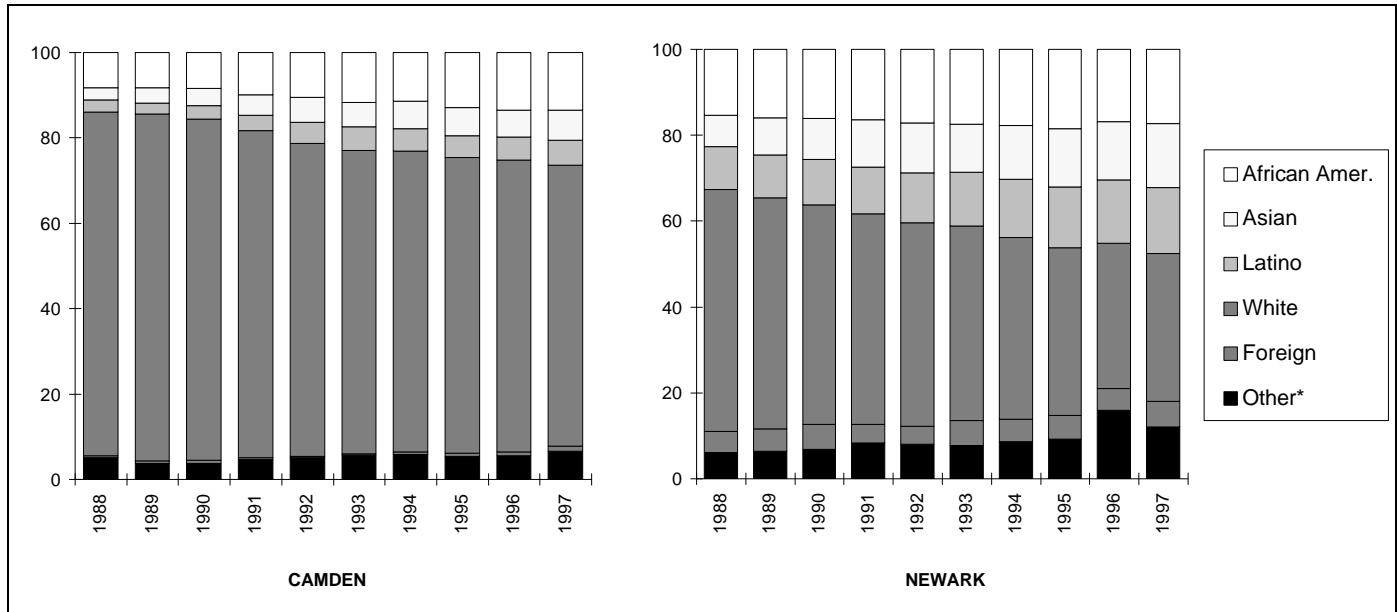
Percent Full-Time Equivalent Enrollment by Gender for New Brunswick Campus and Total University

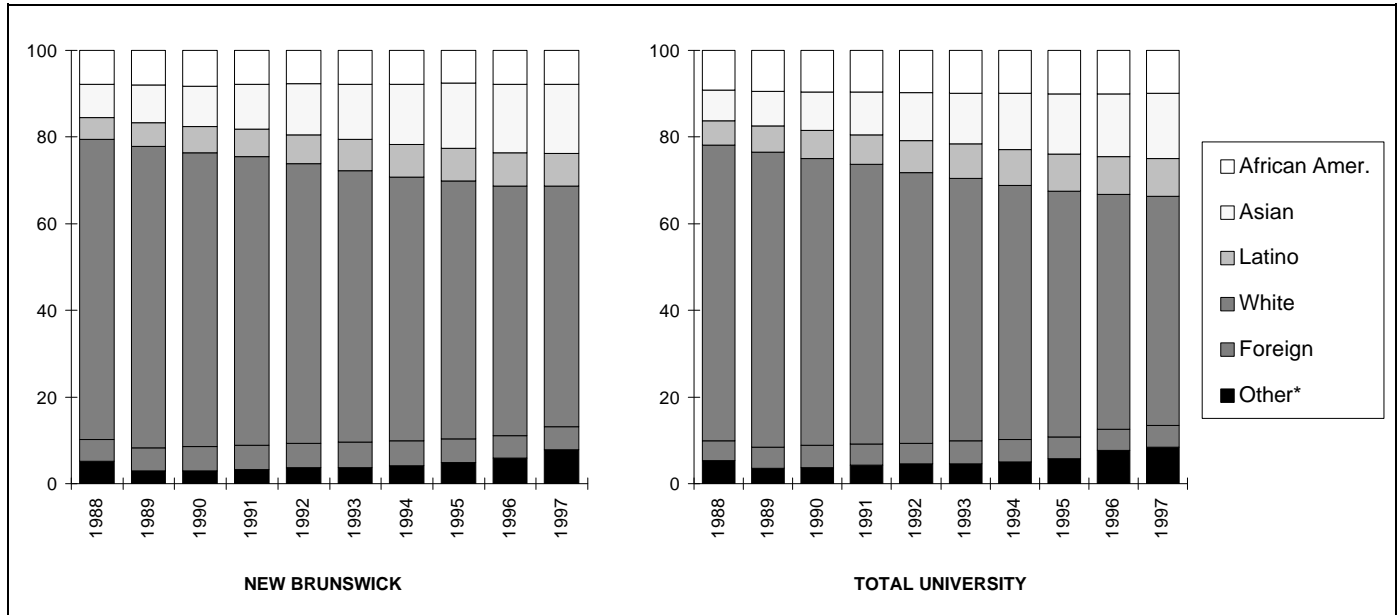

Fall 1988 - 1997

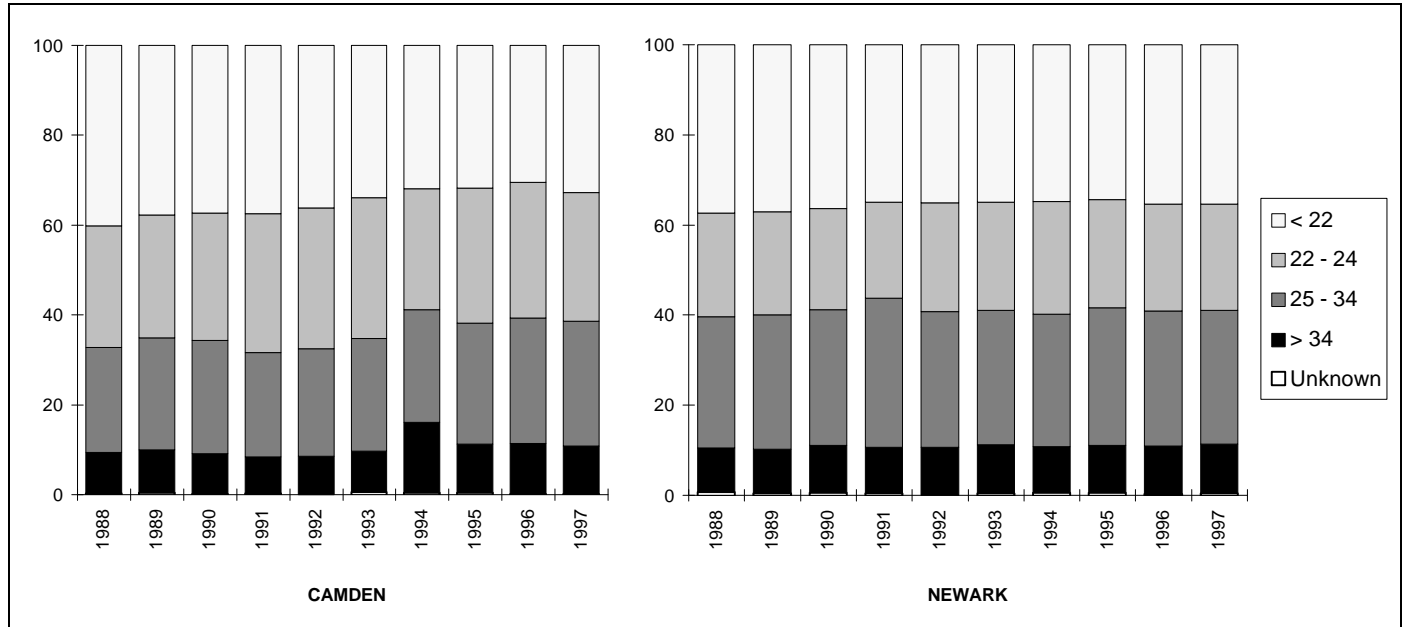

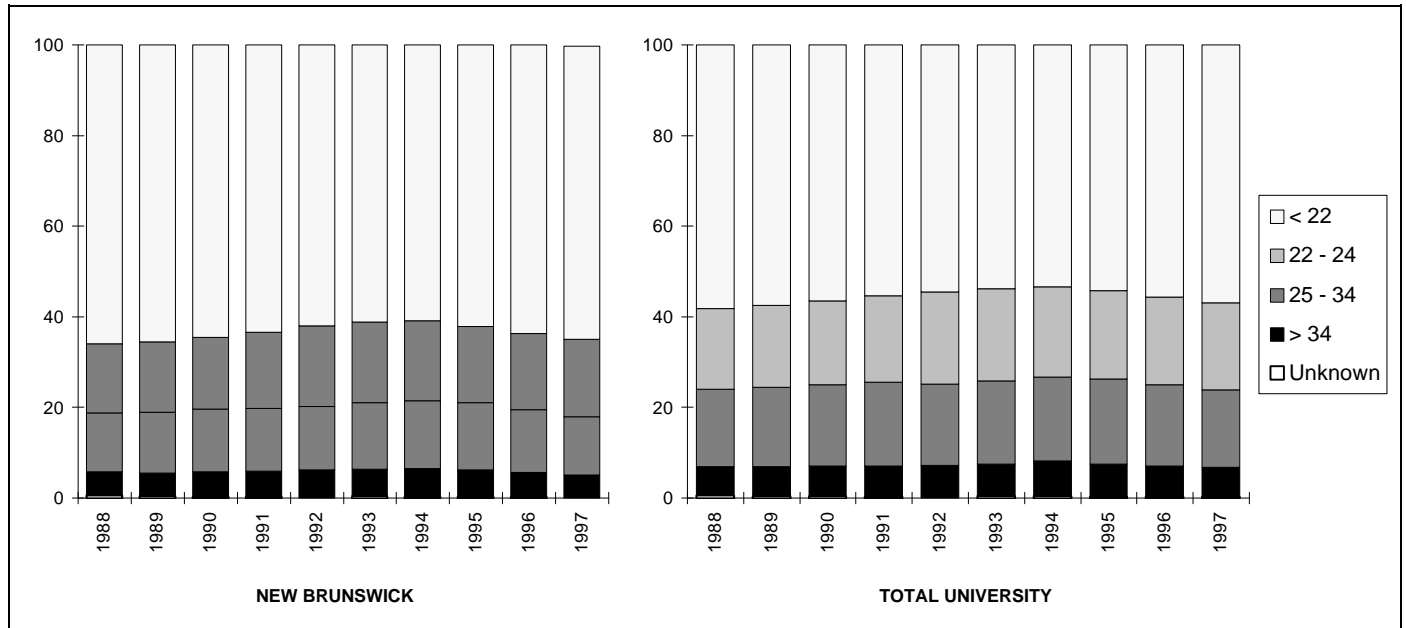
Percent Full-Time Equivalent Enrollment by Age for Camden Campus and Newark Campus

Fall 1988 - 1997

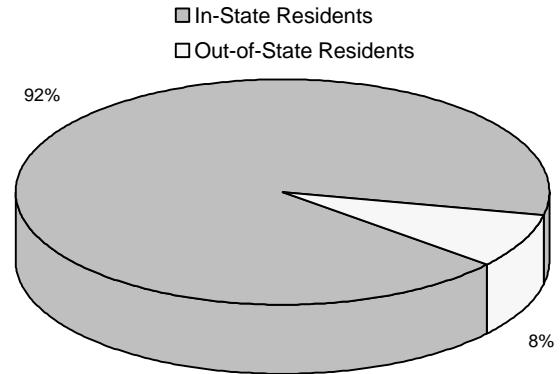

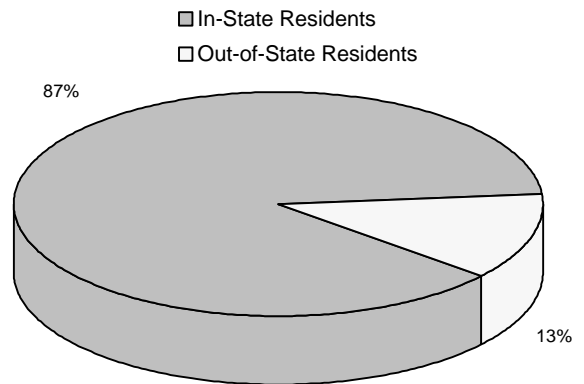

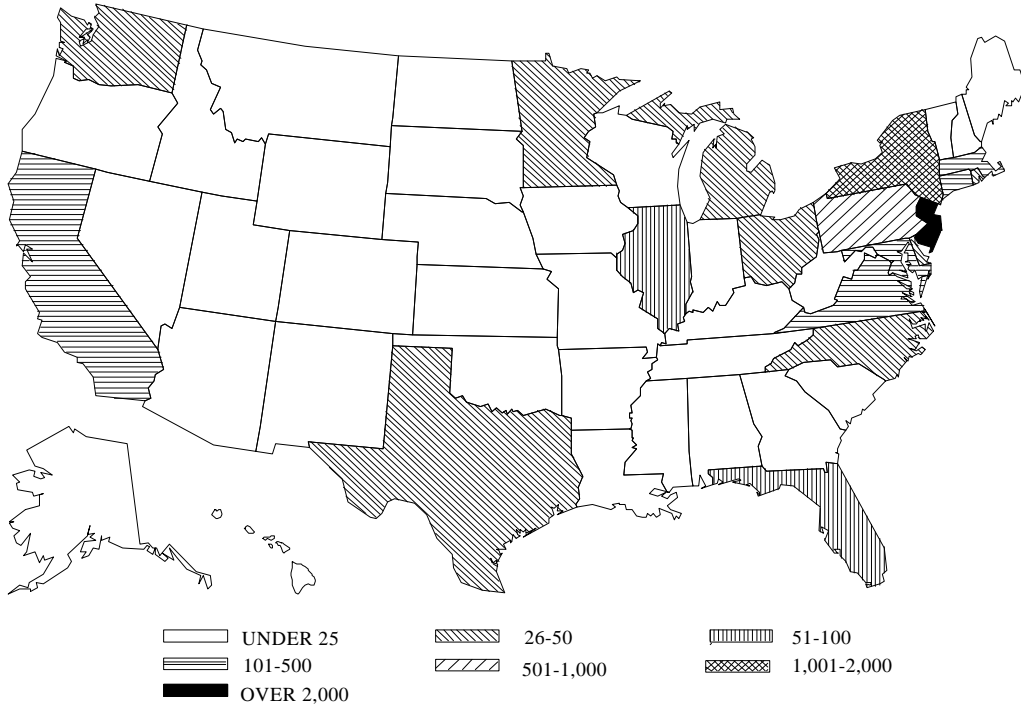

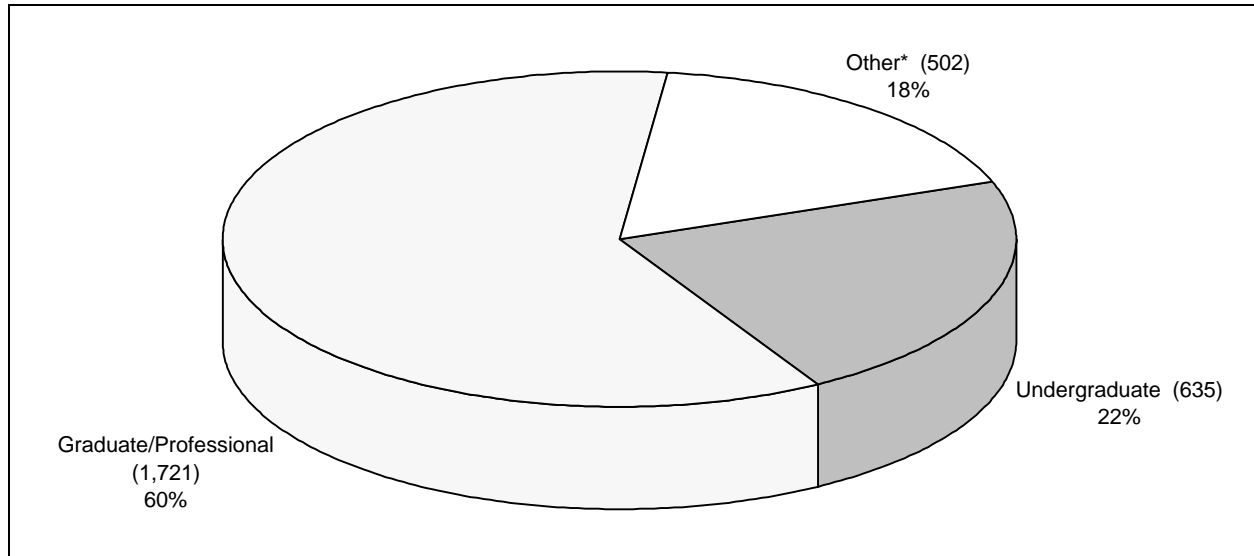
Map of Headcount Enrollment by State
