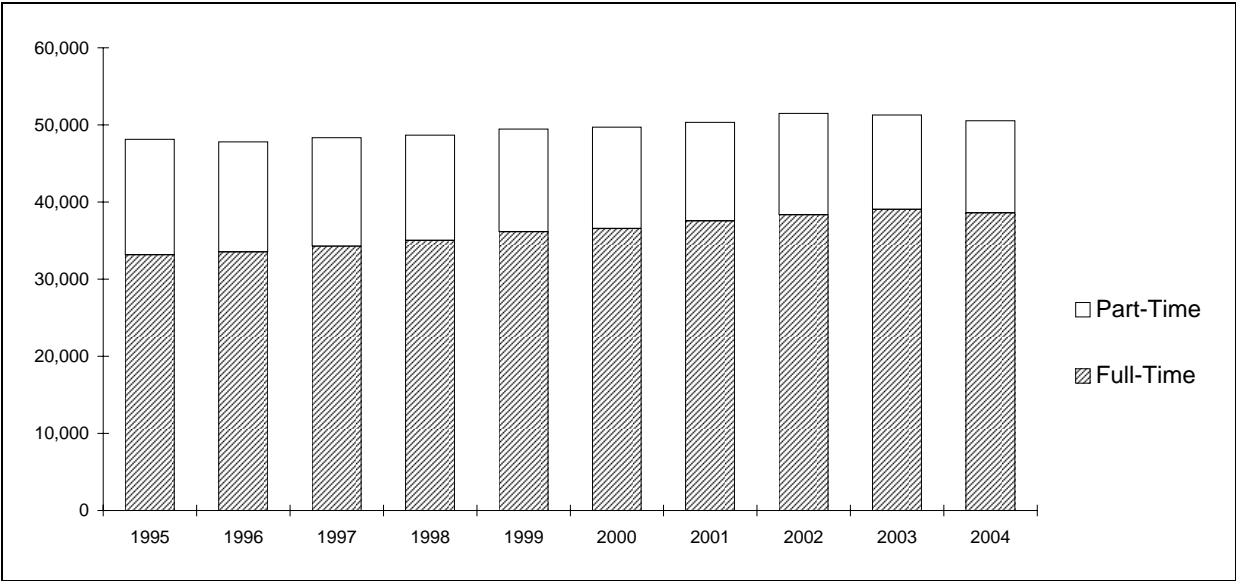

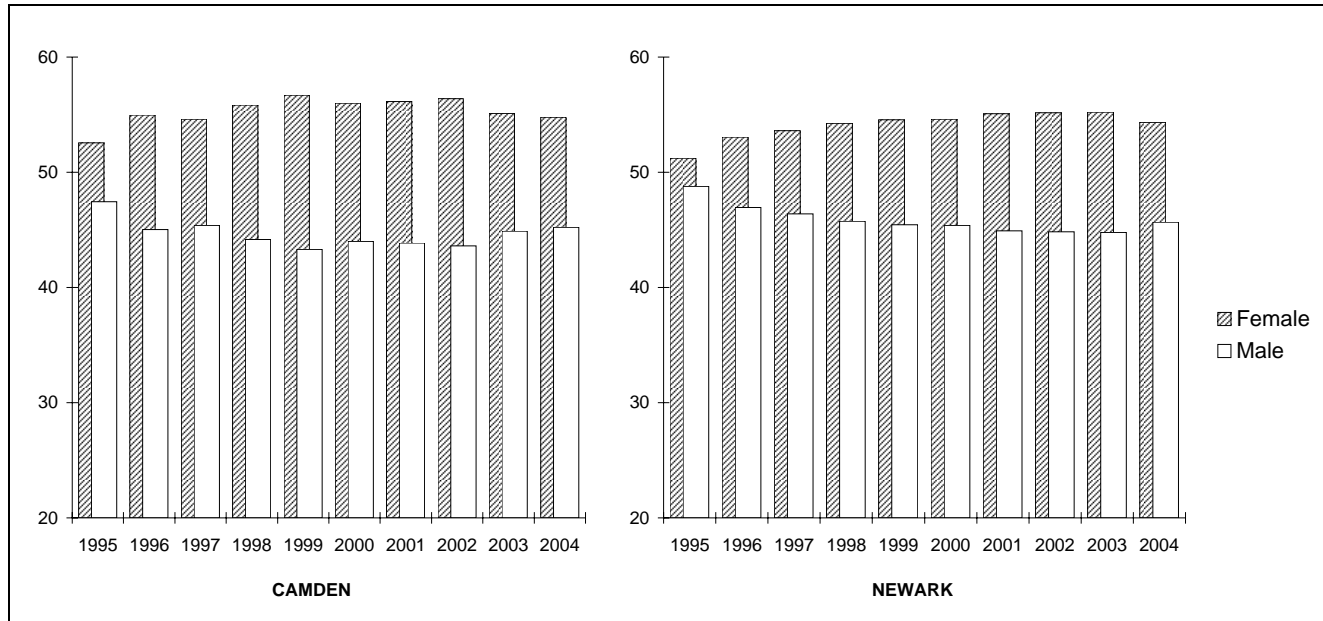

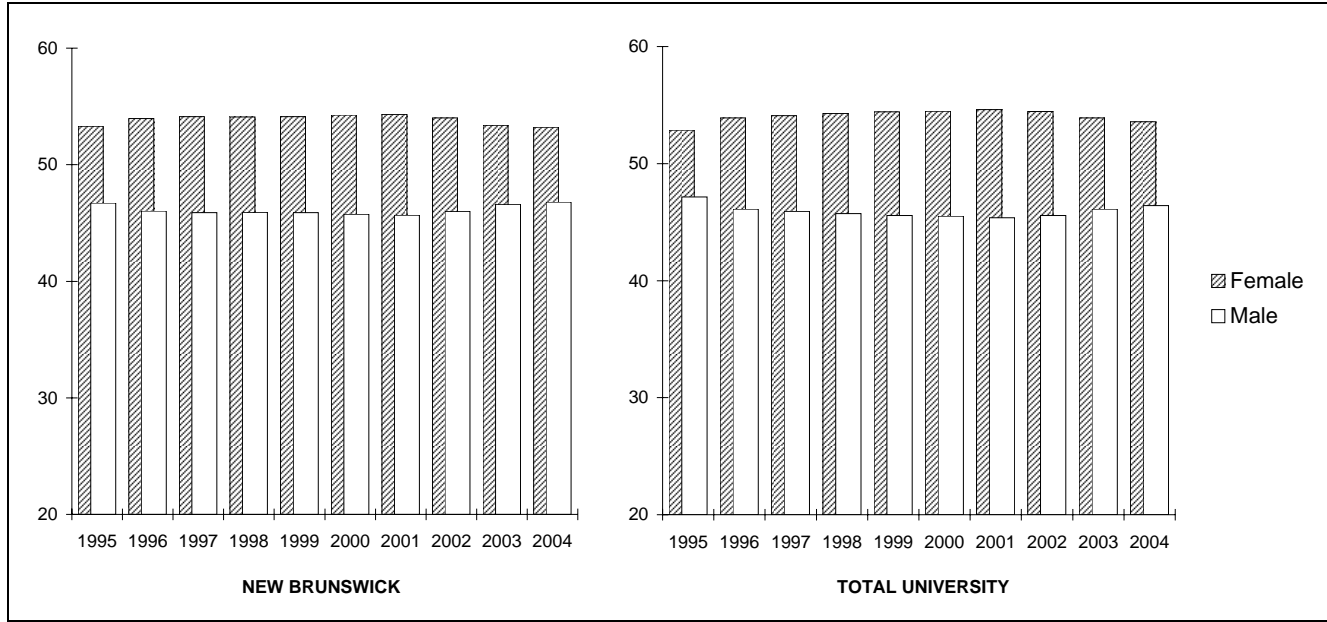
**Percent Full-Time Equivalent Enrollment by Gender for Camden Campus and Newark Campus

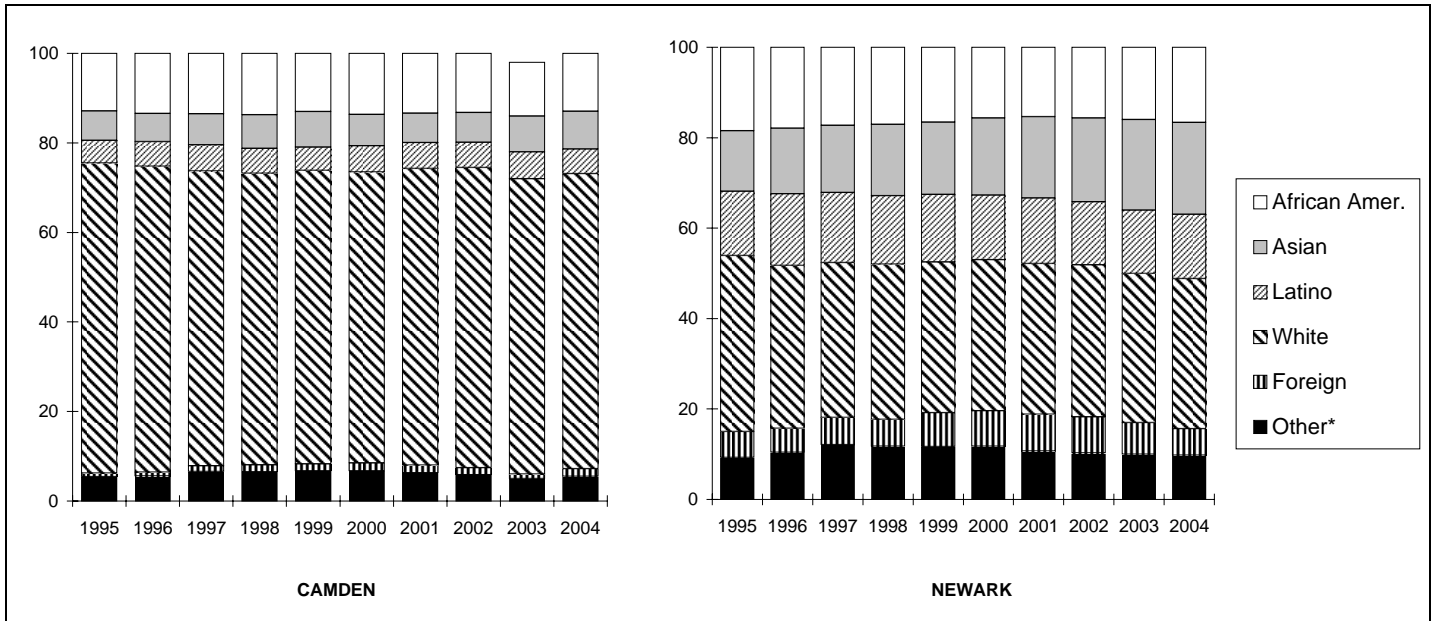
Percent Full-Time Equivalent Enrollment by Gender for New Brunswick Campus and Total University

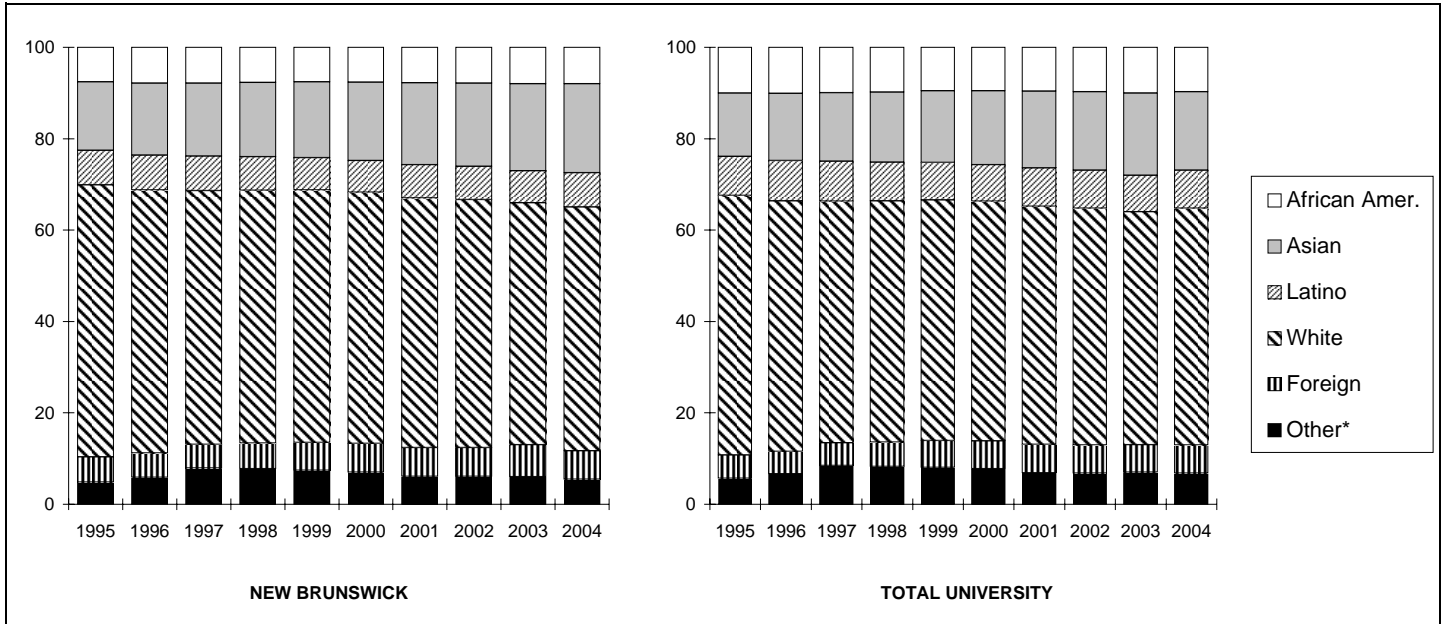

Fall 1995 - 2004



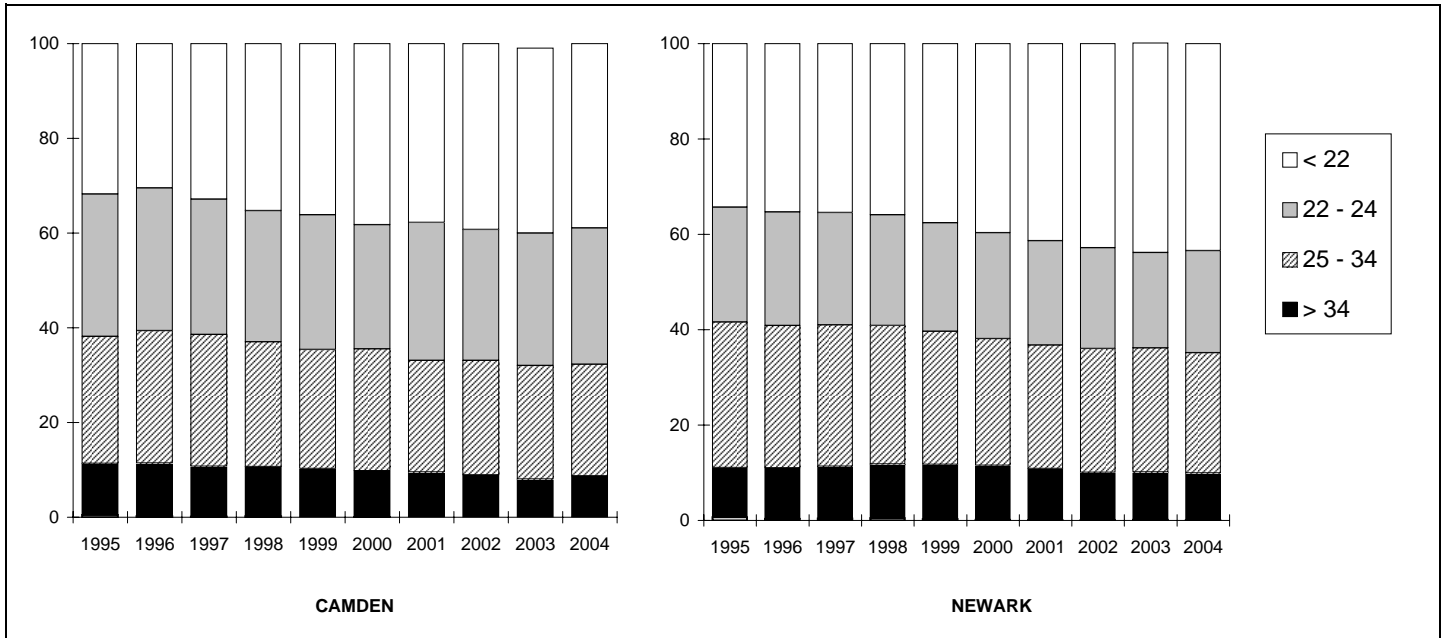

Fall 1995 - 2004

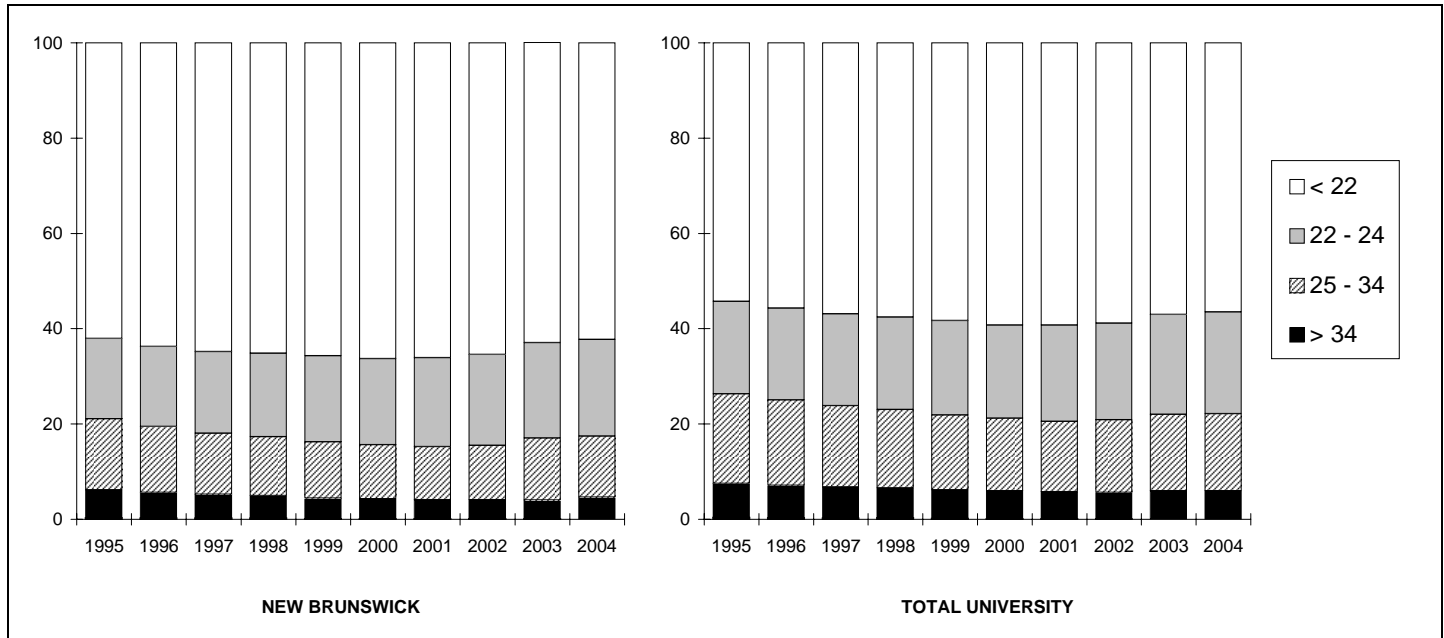

Fall 1995 - 2004

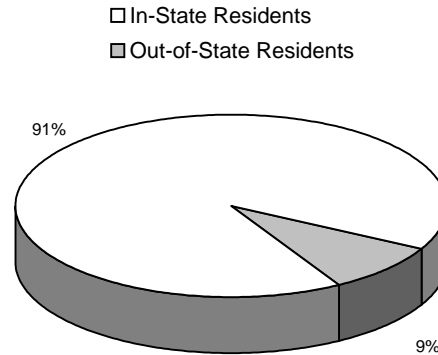

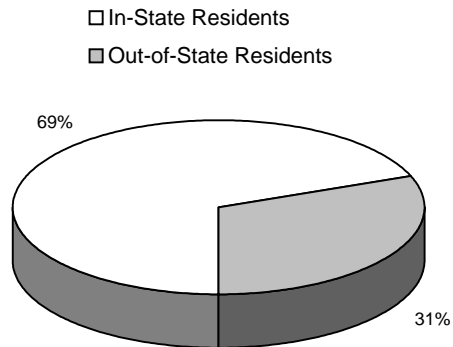

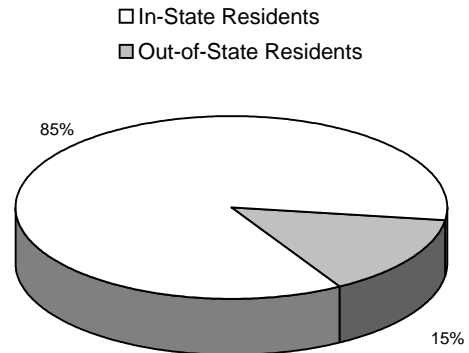

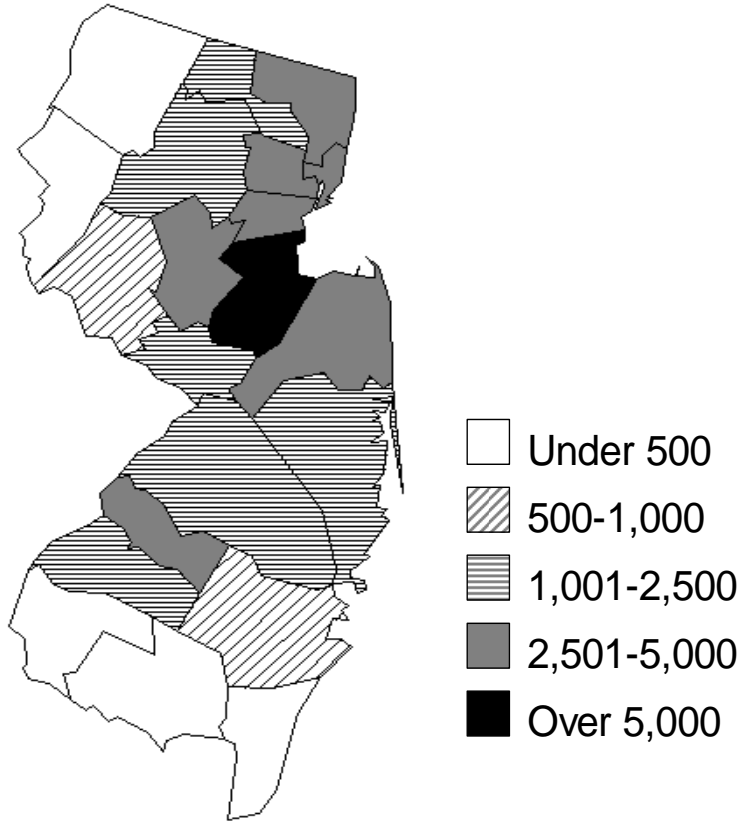

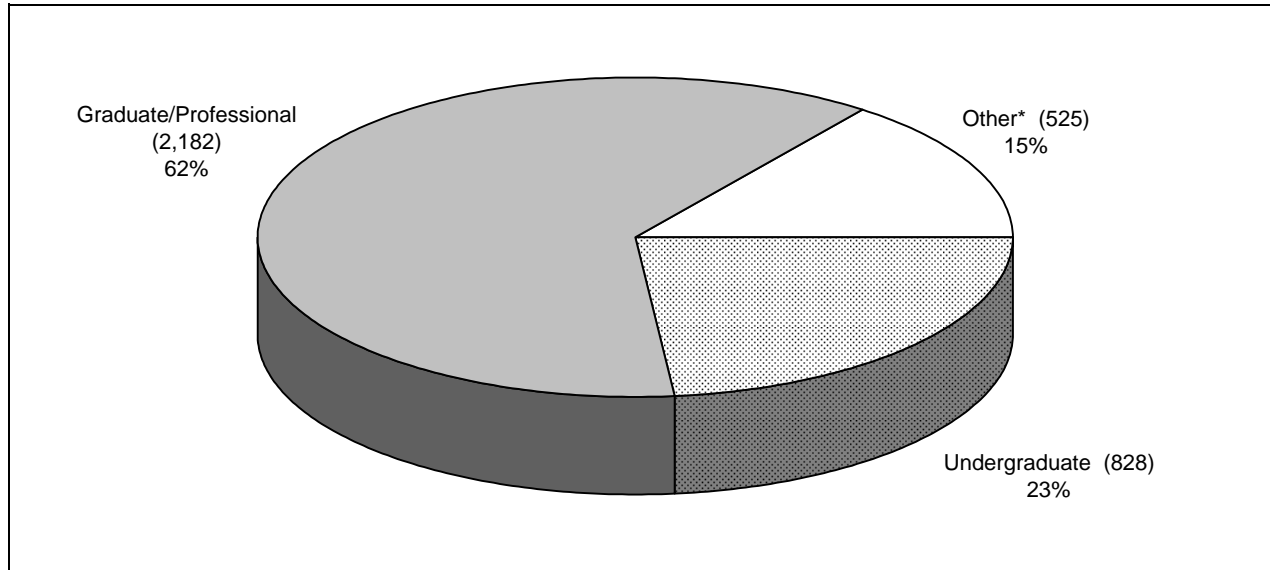
