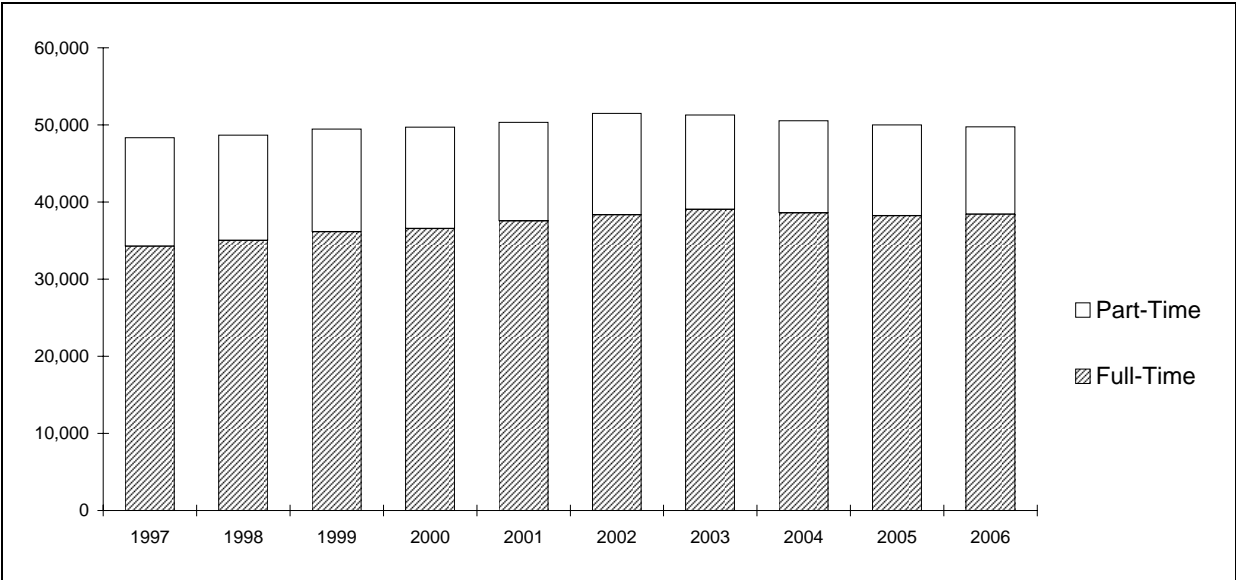

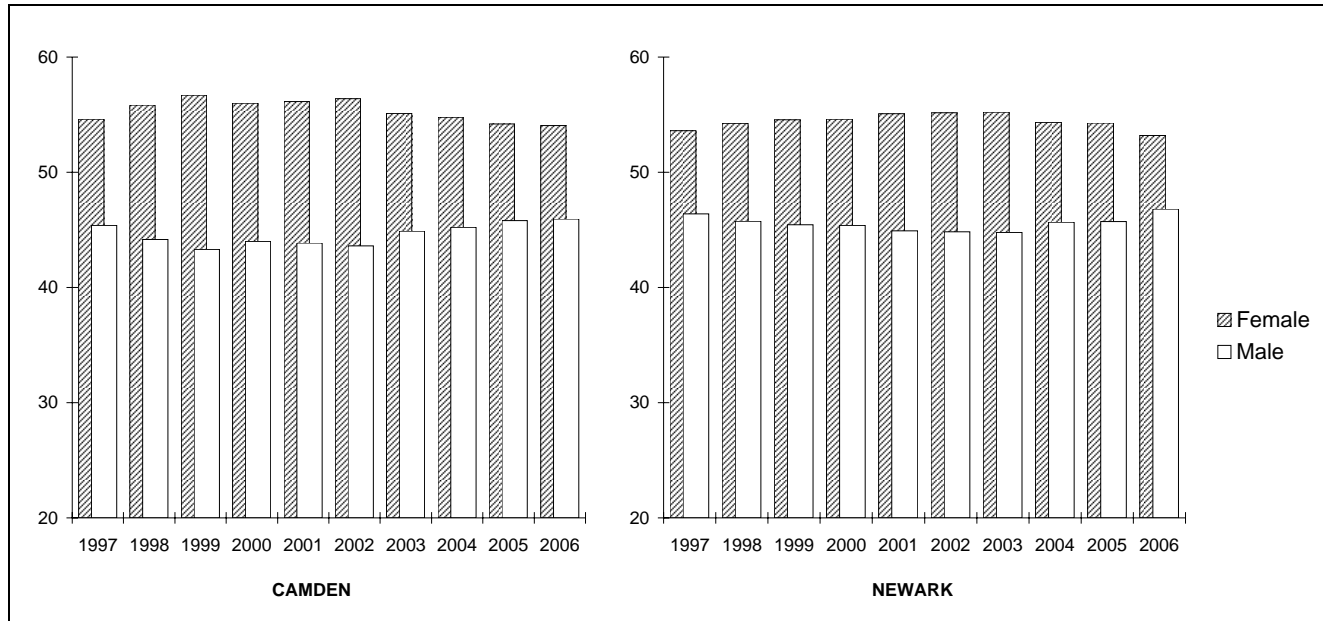

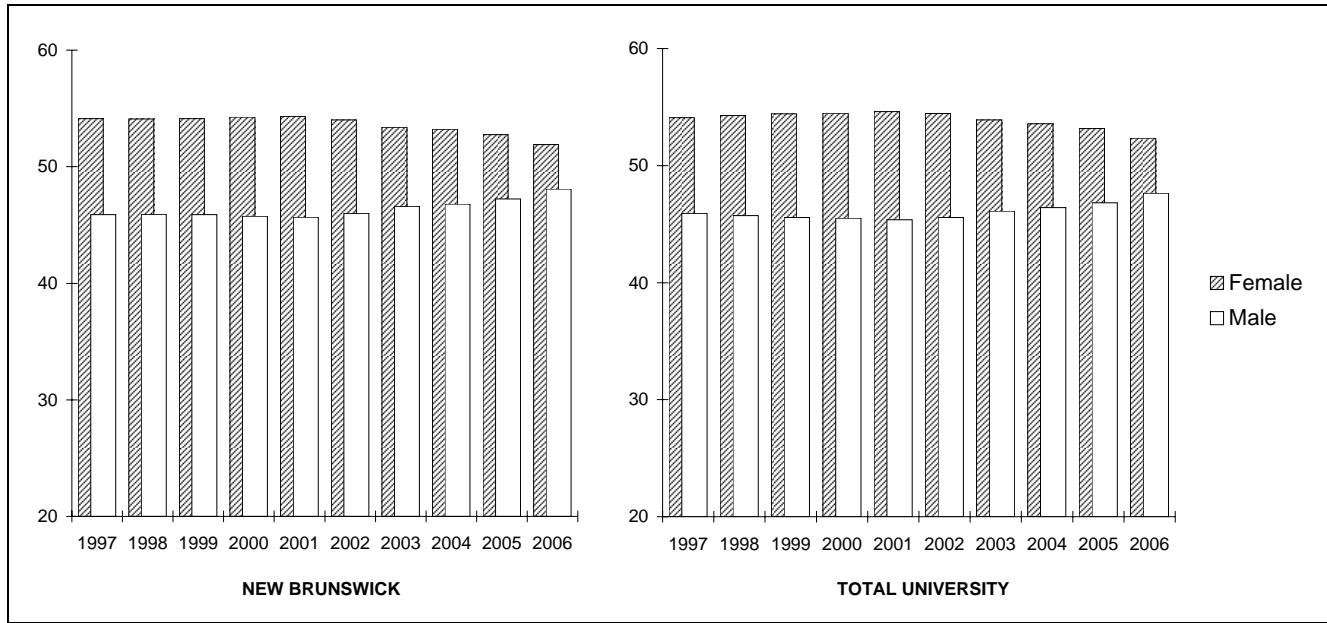
**Percent Full-Time Equivalent Enrollment by Gender for Camden Campus and Newark Campus

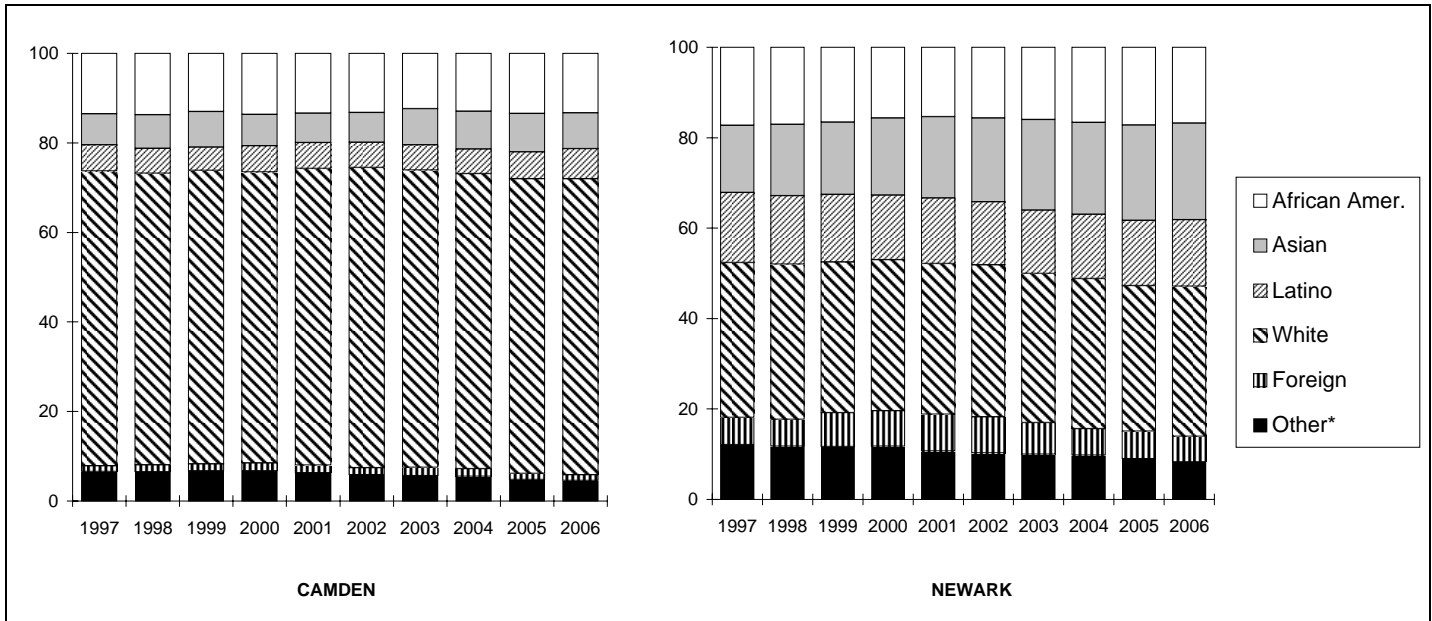
Percent Full-Time Equivalent Enrollment by Gender for New Brunswick Campus and Total University

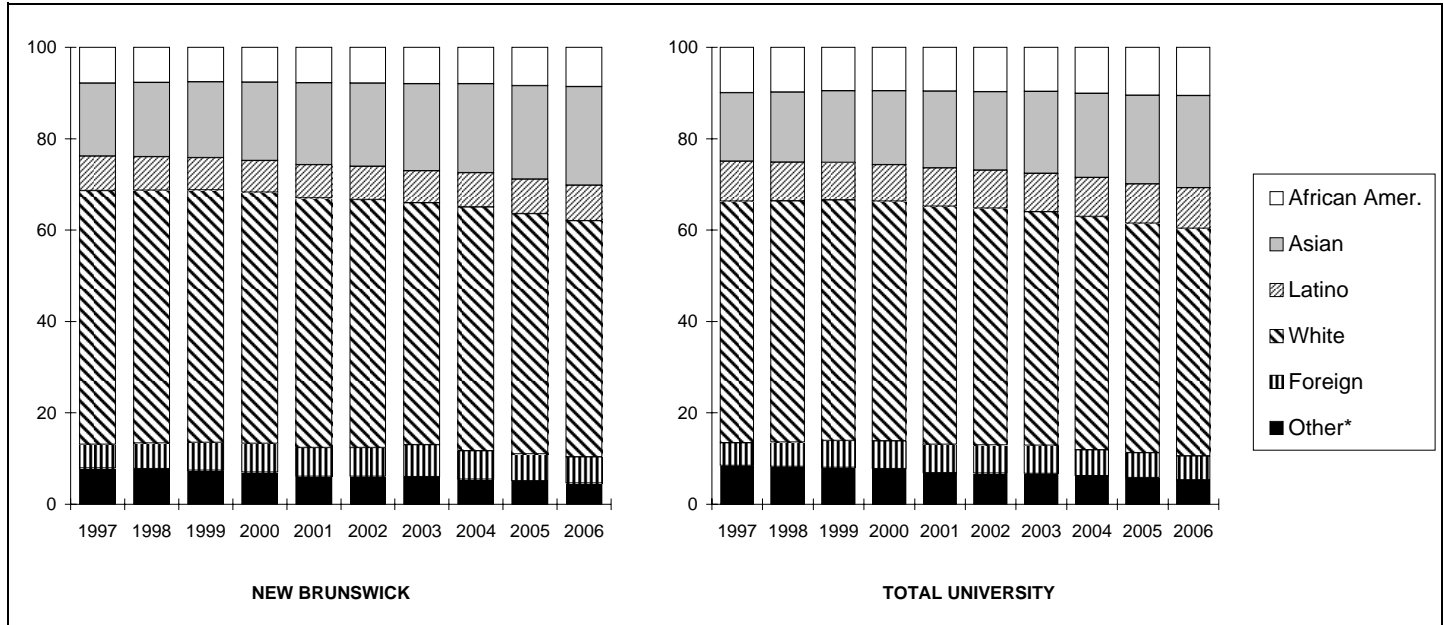

Fall 1997 - 2006



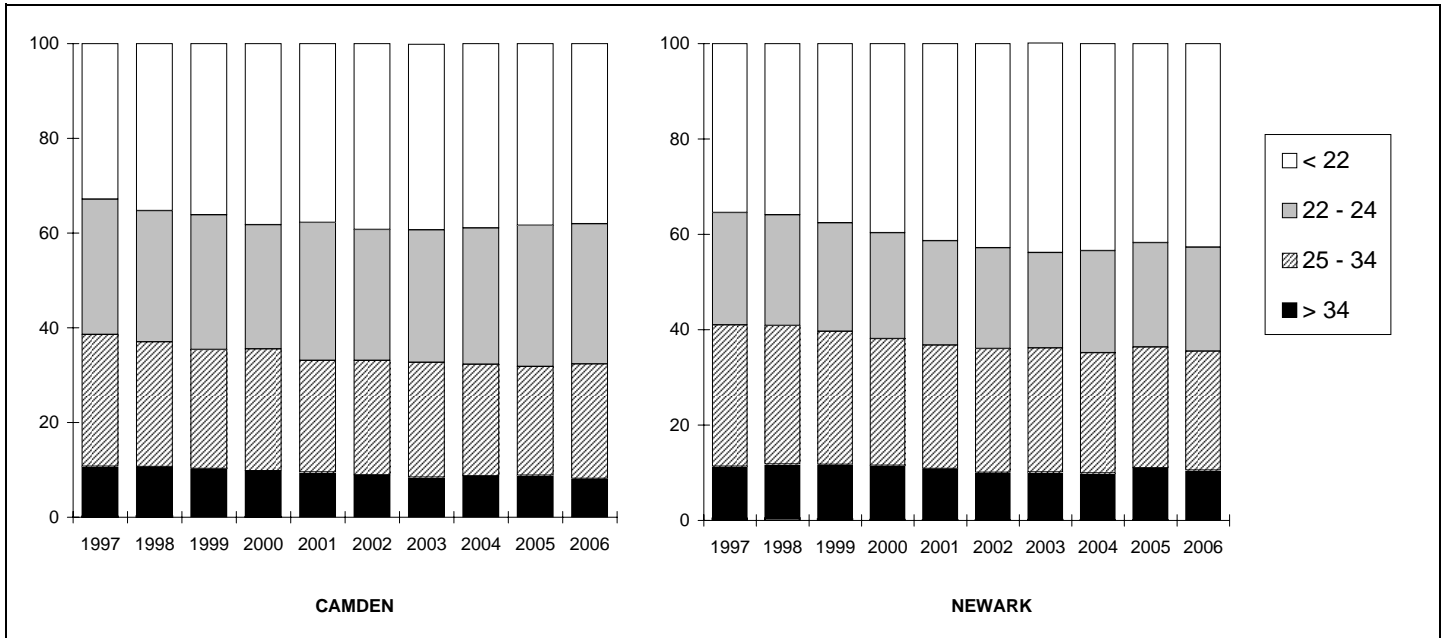

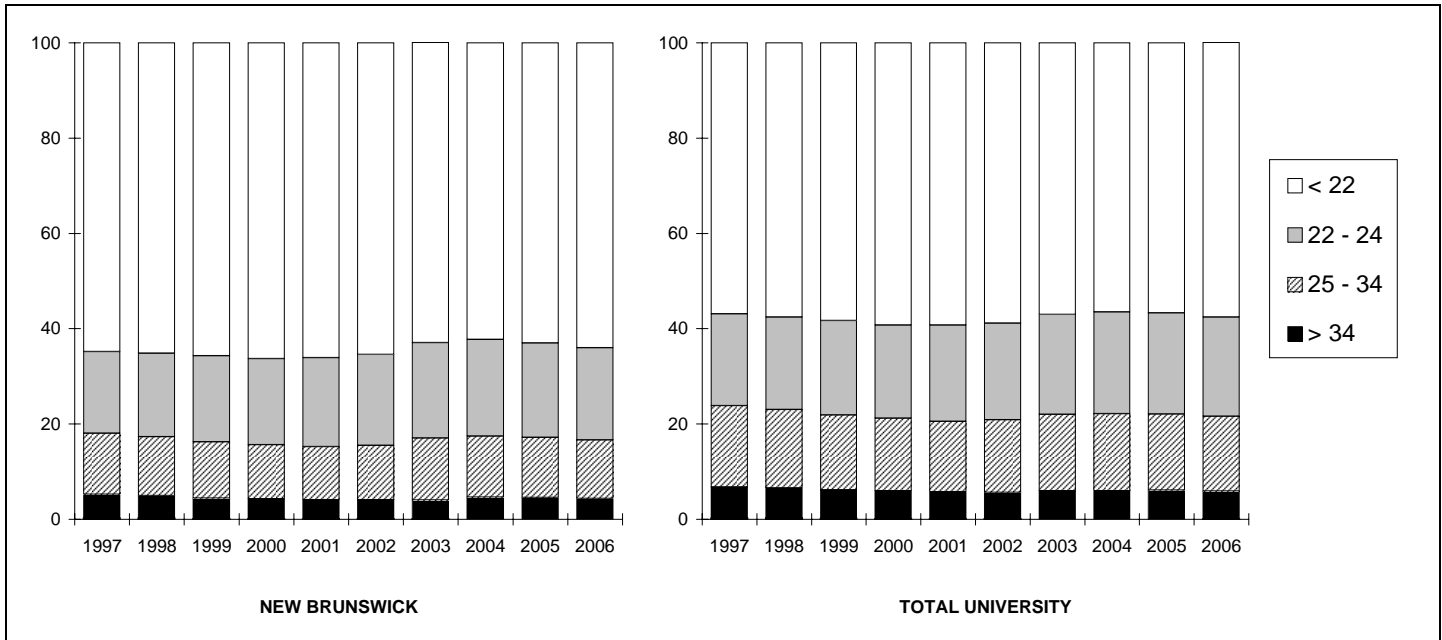

Fall 1997 - 2006

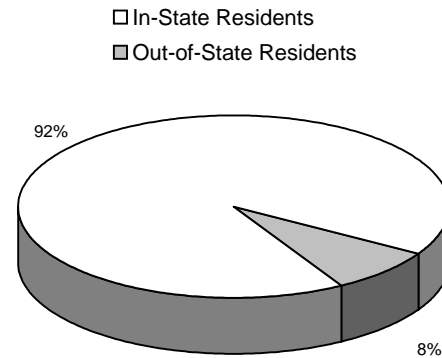

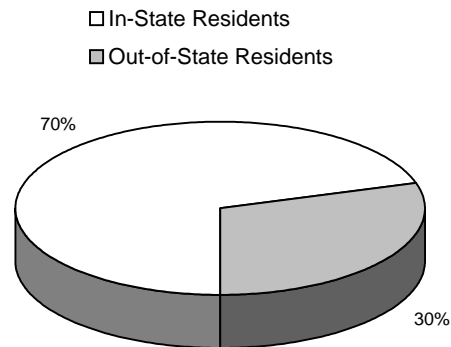

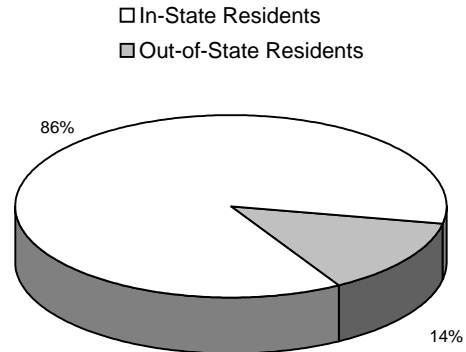

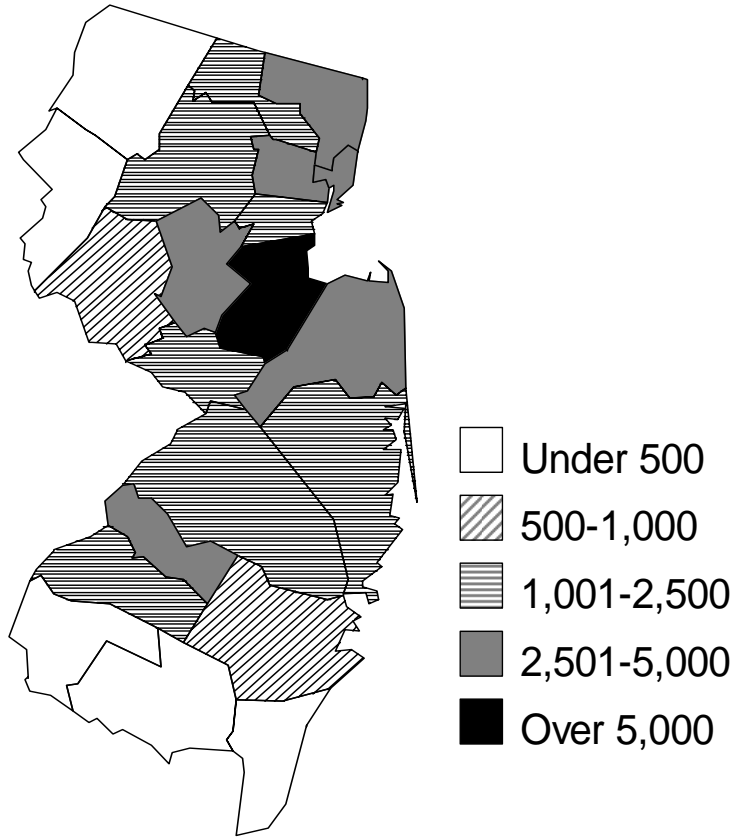

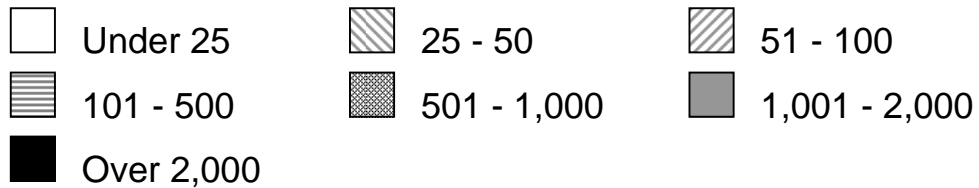
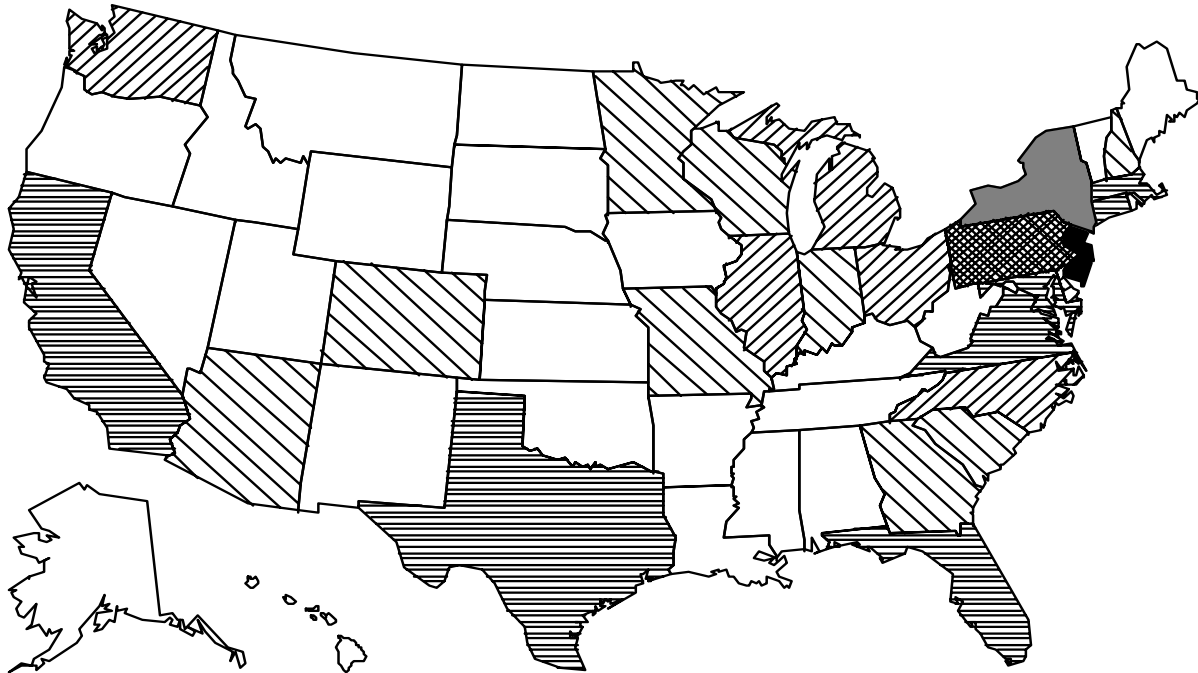

Fall 2006

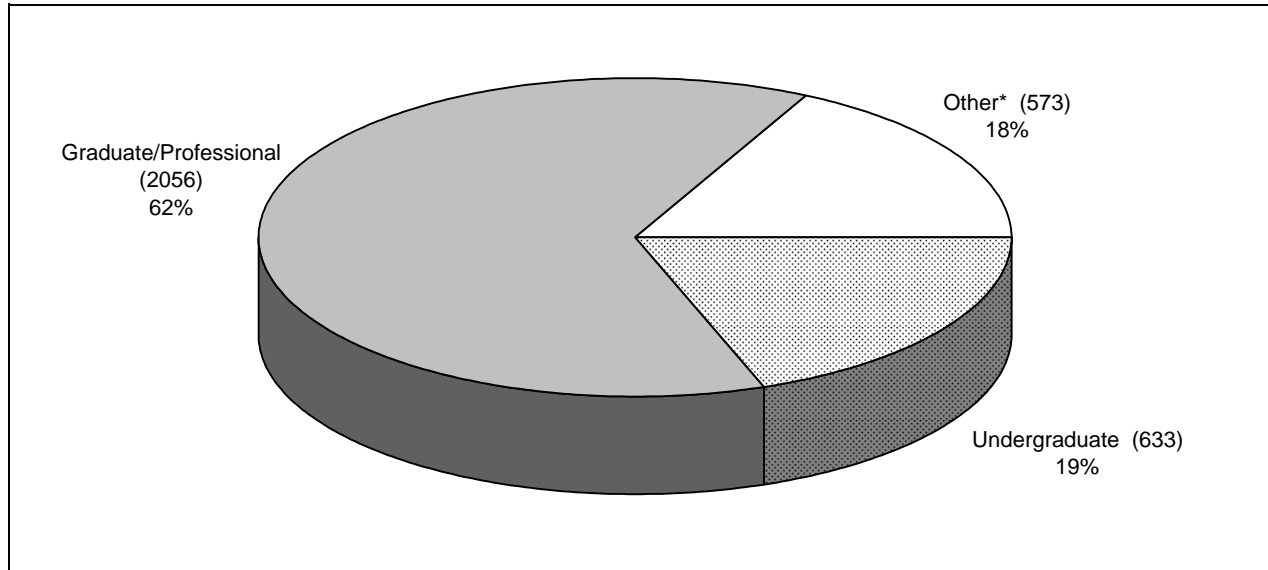
