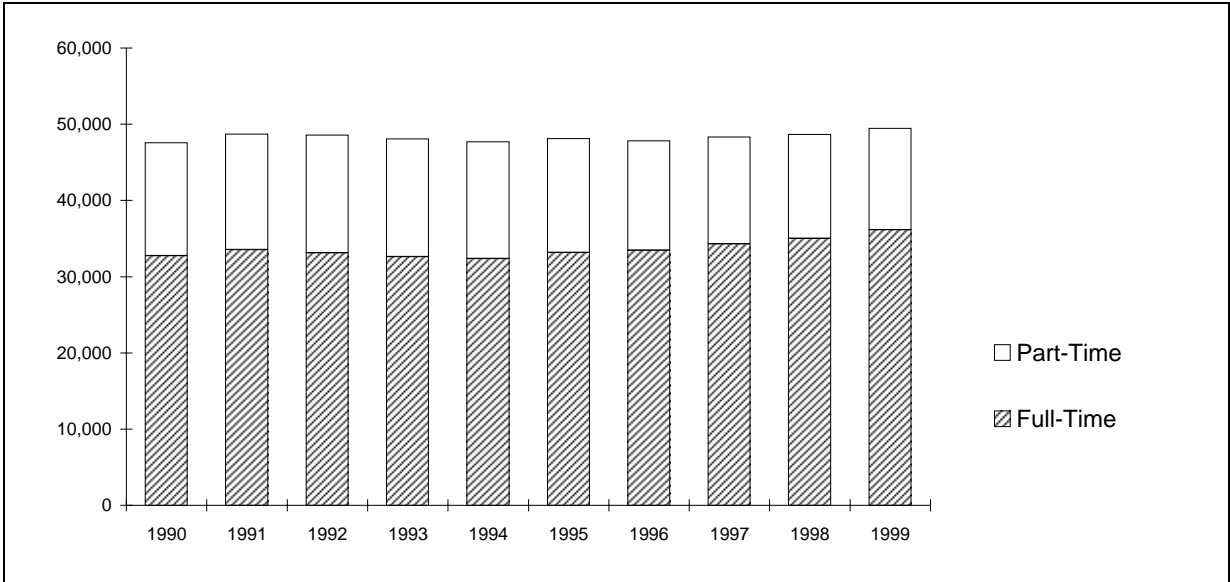

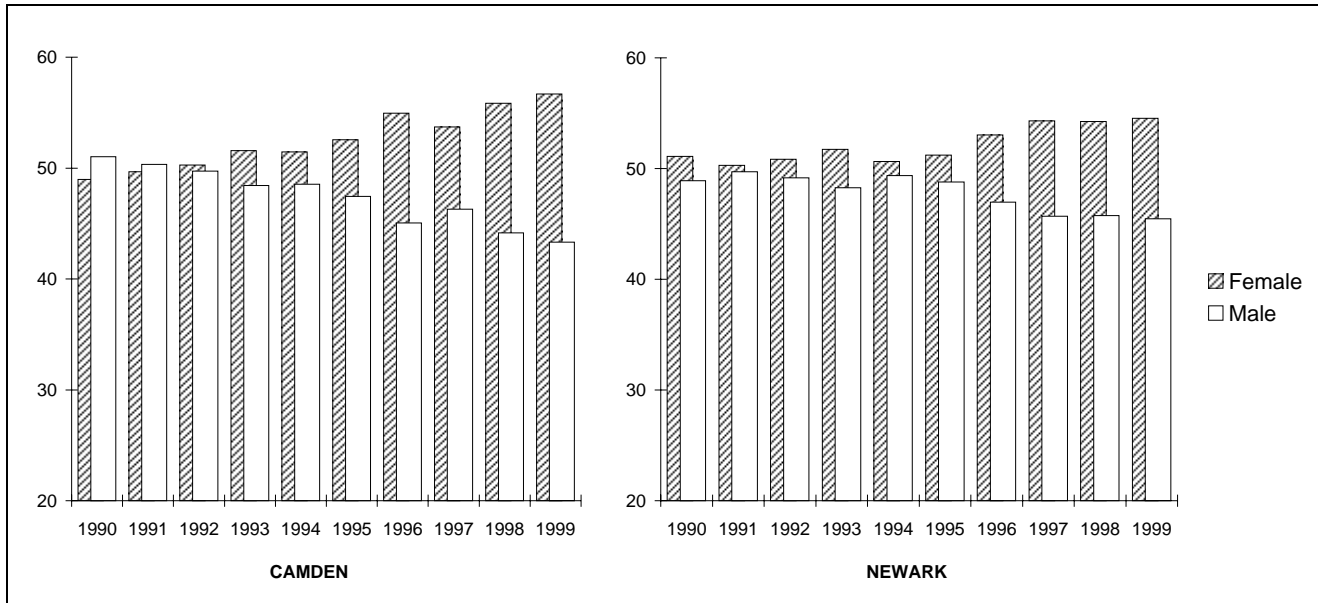

Fall 1990 - 1999

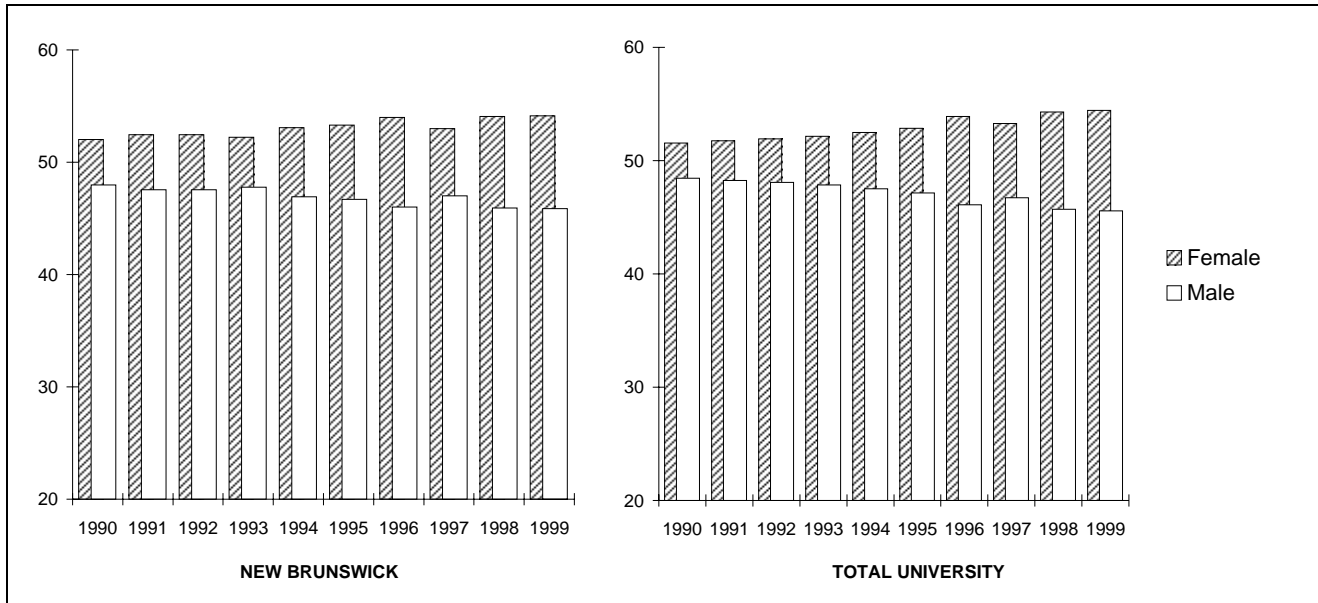

Percent Full-Time Equivalent Enrollment by Gender for New Brunswick Campus and Total University

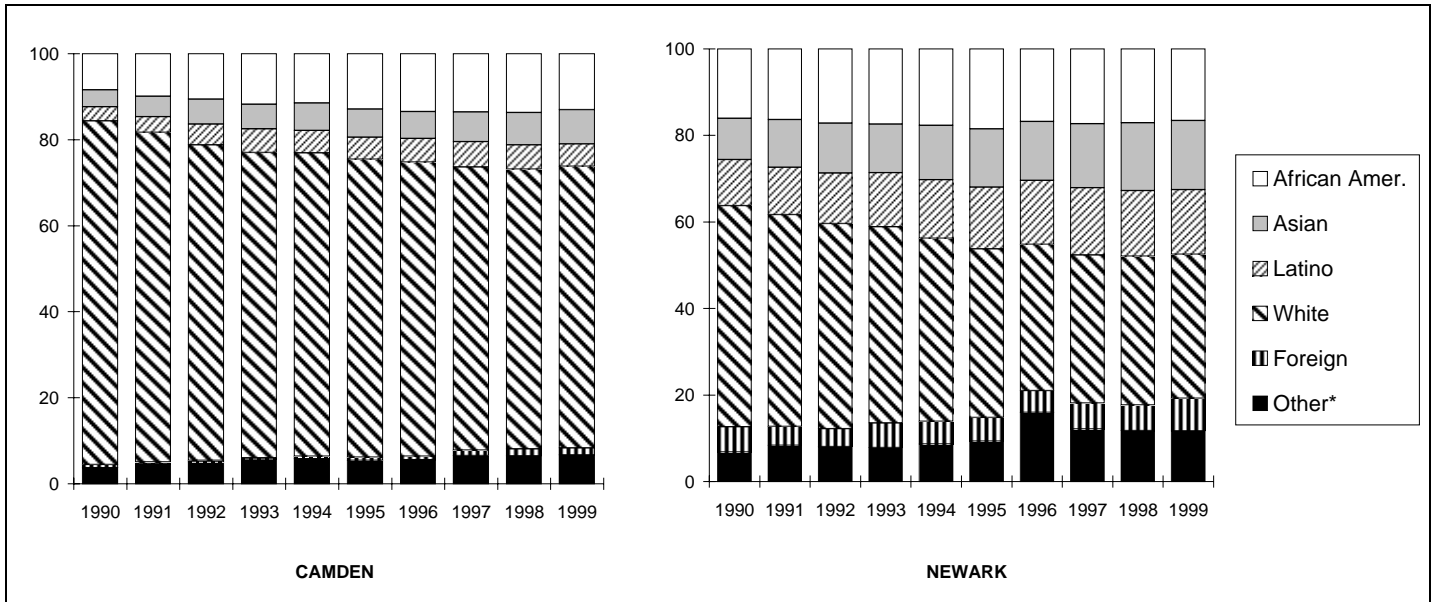

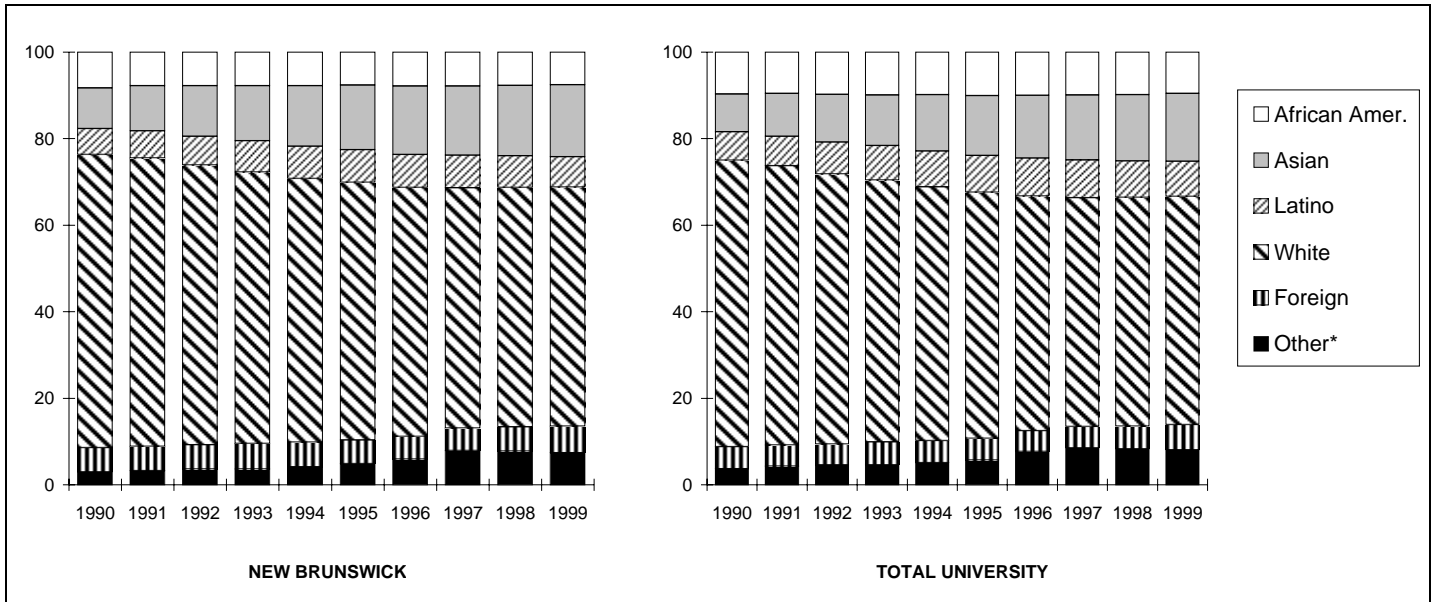

Fall 1990 - 1999

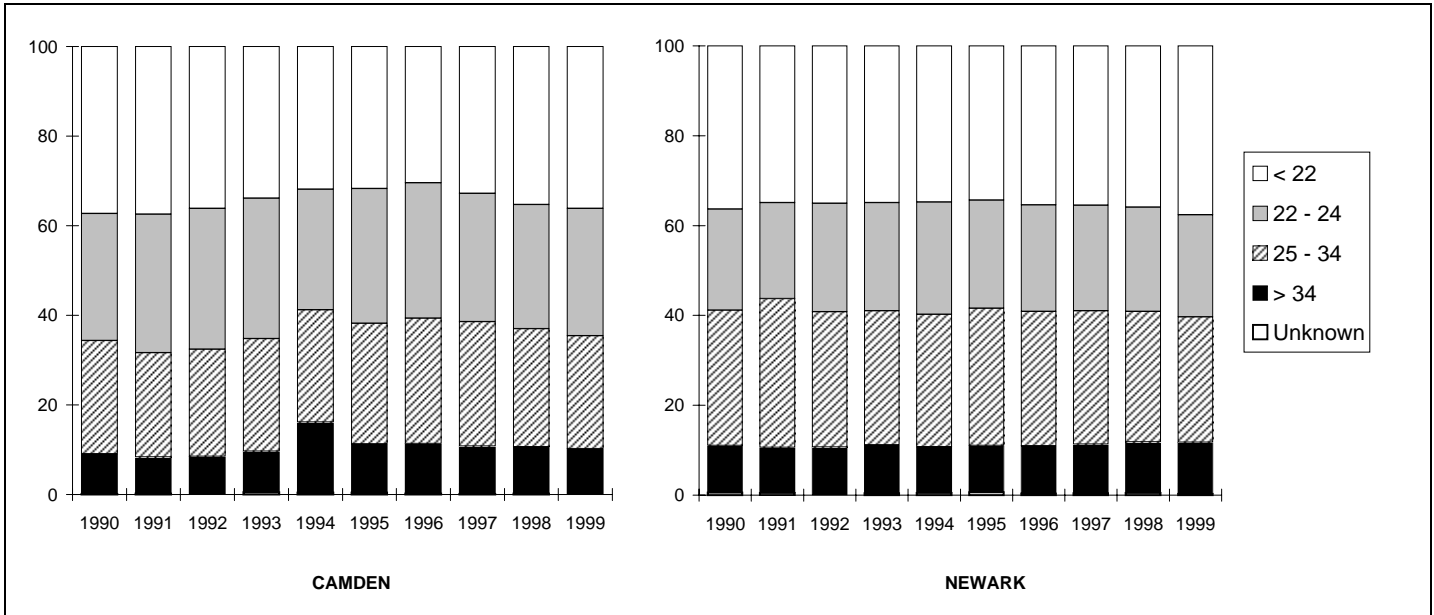

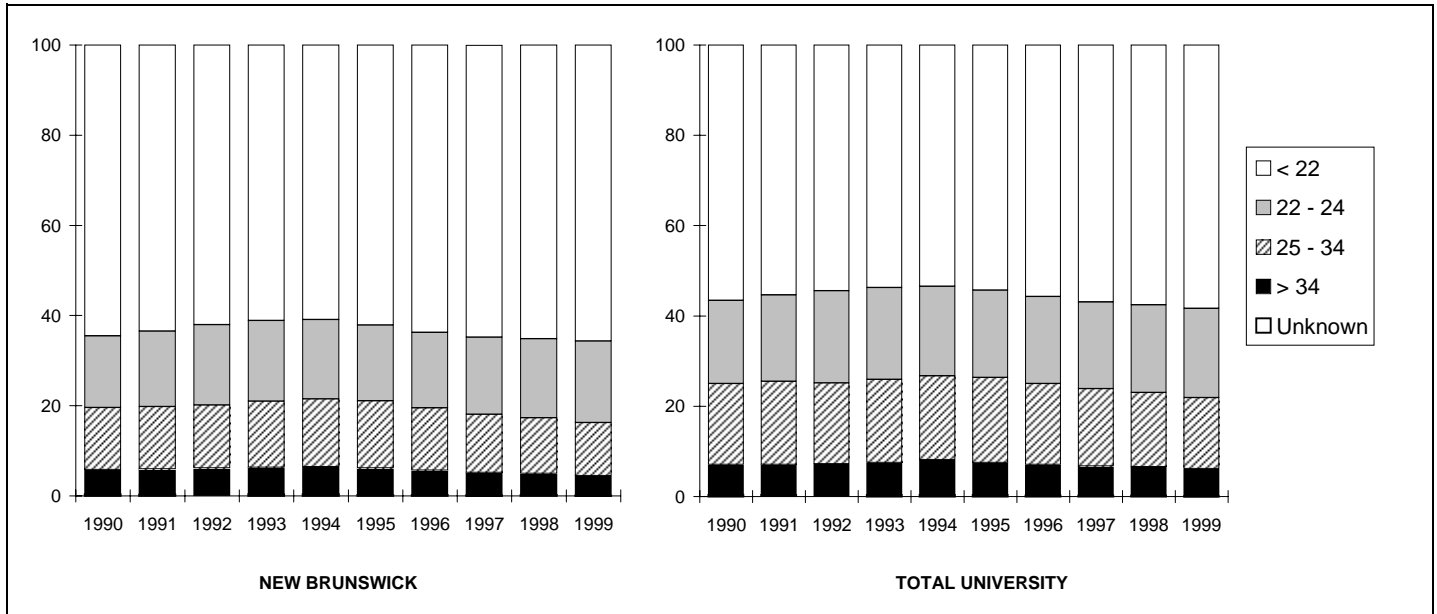
Percent Full-Time Equivalent Enrollment by Age for Camden Campus and Newark Campus

Percent Full-Time Equivalent Enrollment by Age for New Brunswick Campus and Total University

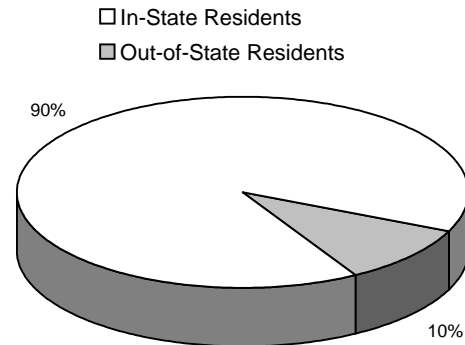

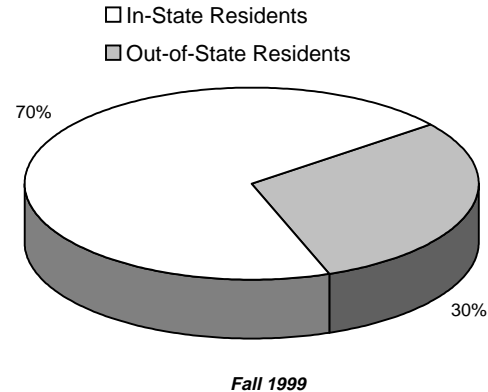

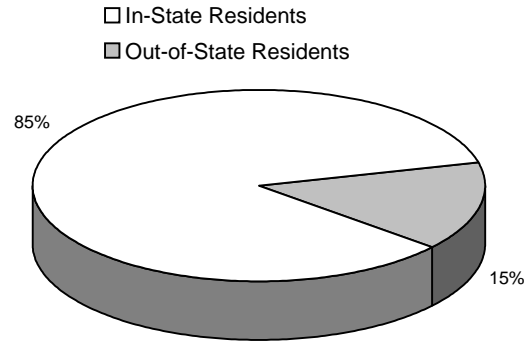

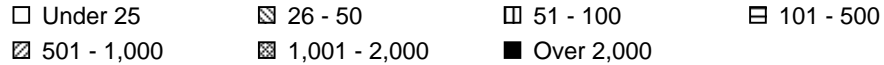
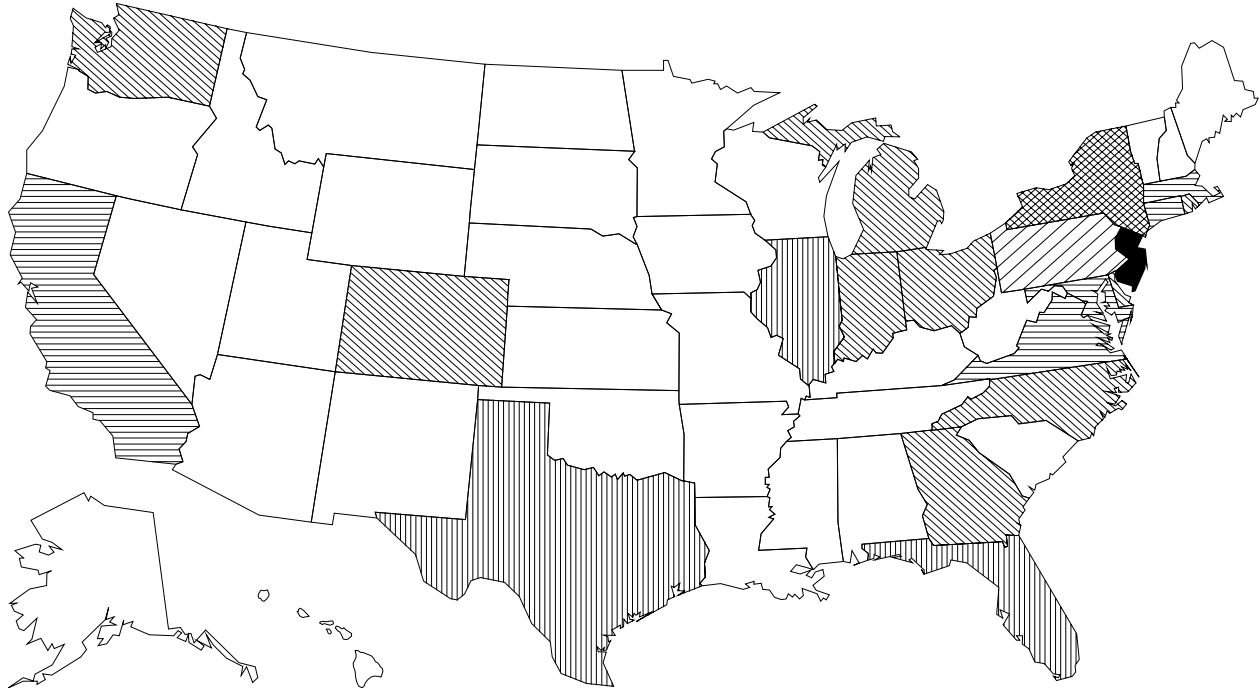

Map of Headcount Enrollment by State

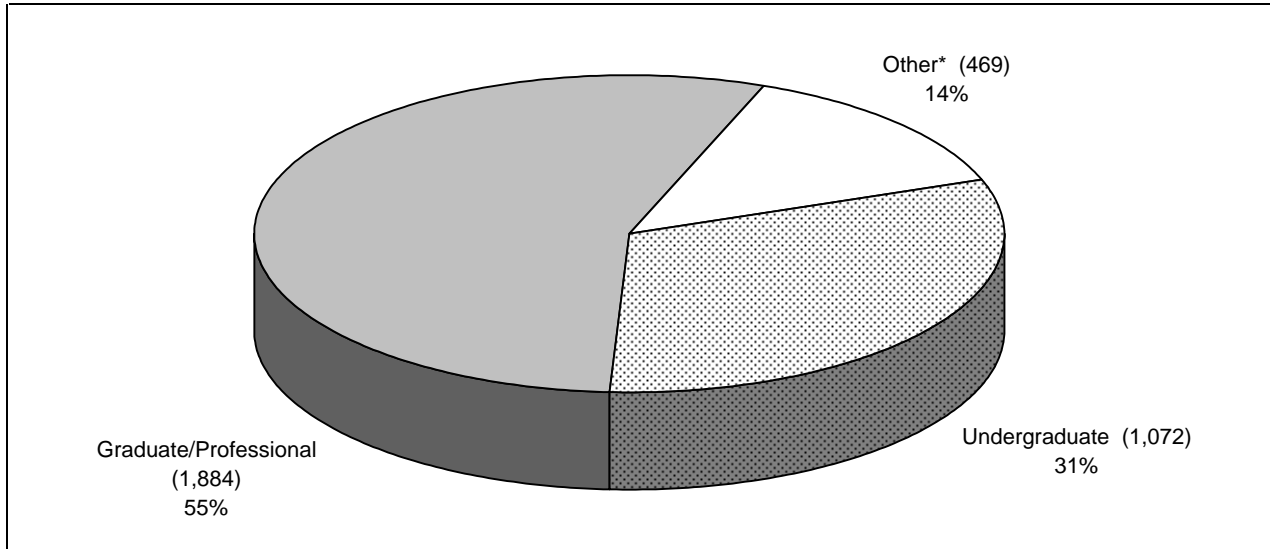
