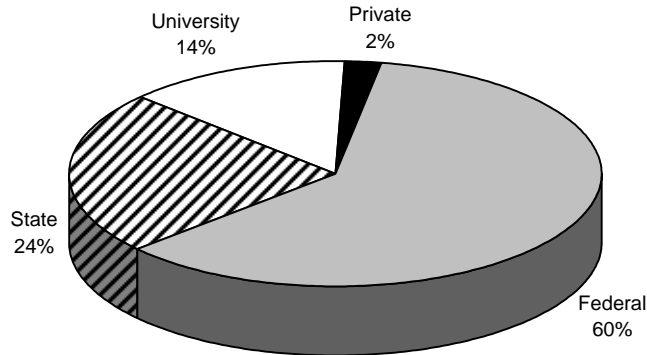

Distribution of Aid (Dollars) by Source



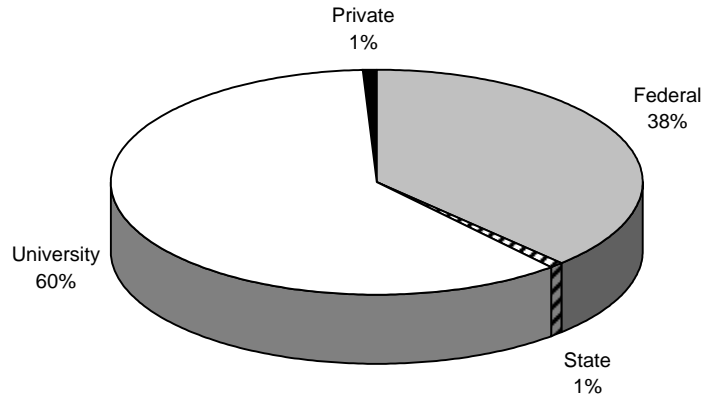
