BUDGET FACTS AND FIGURES

New Jersey Budget Process Timeline

October Rutgers submits its budget request to the state treasurer and the

Commission on Higher Education.

February At an address to a special joint session of the legislature, the

governor submits his state budget proposal. (New governors may

get an extension to March.)

March The Assembly Budget Committee and the Senate Budget and

Appropriations Committee hold public hearings.

March/April College and university presidents and the head of the Commission

on Higher Education give budget testimony before the appropriate

legislative committees.

April Rutgers Board of Governors holds an annual public hearing on

tuition and fees for the coming year.

June The legislature passes the fiscal year budget, which the governor

must sign by June 30. The budget becomes effective July 1.

June/July Rutgers Board of Governors sets tuition and fees, and establishes a

working budget for the fiscal year.
