Dorothy L. Hodgson (Anthropology) has been elected to serve a three-year term as the IRW Director. The first social scientist to direct the IRW, she is focused on further expanding the Institute's interdisciplinary partnerships and developing additional programs offering multinational perspectives.

Since the IRW interdisciplinary research seminar began in the 1996-1997 academic year, the IRW has hosted more than 45 visiting scholars and Rockefeller Resident Fellows in the Humanities. Intern Ariel Zander (Women's and Gender Studies) has just completed a web project compiling information and weblinks about <u>who's been at the IRW</u> and their subsequent publications as well as their projects during their terms at Rutgers.
