Review Process & Timeline

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1. Priorities Committee is divided into five subcommittees each led by co-chairs who serve on Priorities Executive Committee.

- 2. 650+ proposals are randomly assigned to the five subcommittees of the Priorities Committee.
- 3. Each subcommittee-assigned proposal is then randomly assigned to four random readers within the subcommittee. Those four readers are responsible for rating and commenting on proposals.
- 4. Subcommittee members are responsible to read, rate and comment on the proposals they are assigned but have the flexibility to read as many proposals they would like.
- 5. Rutgers University Foundation office will take results of scorecards and compile. These results will be provided to Subcommittee Chairs.
- 6. Subcommittee Chairs will determine which ones of the assigned proposals require further discussion.
- 7. Subcommittee chairs will meet with their respective subcommittees to review proposals requiring additional discussion.
- 8. Subcommittee chairs will make final recommendations to the Priorities Executive Committee. The Priorities Executive Committee will meet to develop and finalize results into recommended prospectus for campaign.
