- Arts and sciences students will be served by Academic Advising Centers on each of the campuses at Rutgers–New Brunswick.
- The Douglass Residential College will provide women at Rutgers with a small, close-knit community focusing on women's leadership.
- Improved student services, a campuswide honors program, and "discovery houses" on the Livingston Campus will enrich the student experience for Rutgers undergraduates.
