Examinations

Each legislative body shall determine its final examination policy and procedures within the limits established by the following Regulations:

- (1) In courses in which final examinations are required, no student may be permitted to take a deferred examination unless his or her absence from the scheduled examination is excused in accordance with the provisions of the section of these Regulations pertaining to attendance.
- (2) Special examination may be given to satisfy a prerequisite or graduation requirement of any course.

All regulations and procedures are subject to amendment.
