GRE information may be obtained from the Graduate Record Examination Program, Educational Testing Service, P.O. Box 6000, Princeton, NJ 08541-6000 (609/771-7670). Some programs also require additional tests.

Graduate programs may require that test scores more than five years old be validated, either by evidence of continued work in the field or by reexamination.
