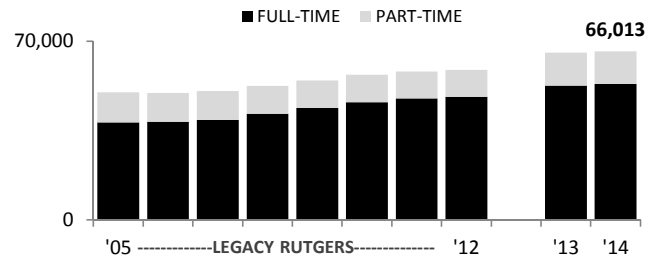

■ Female ■ Male

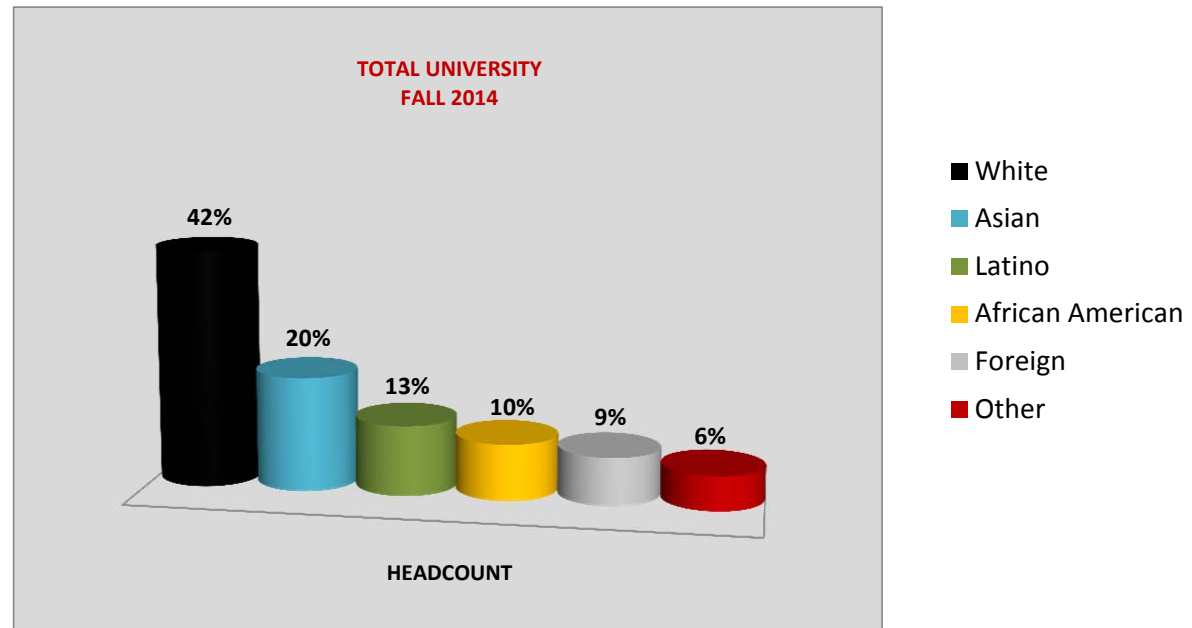

**Percent Enrollment Headcount by Race/Ethnicity for Total University**

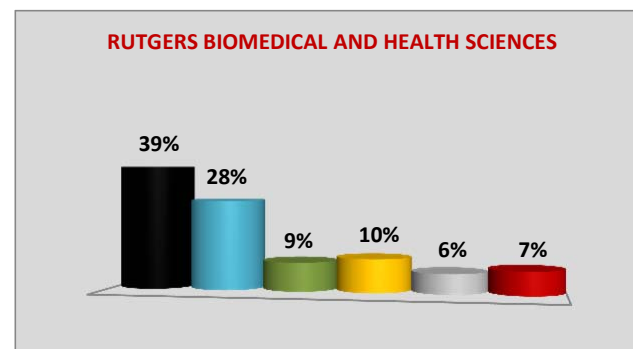
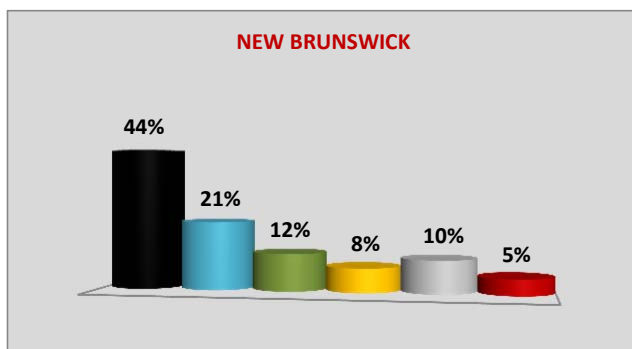
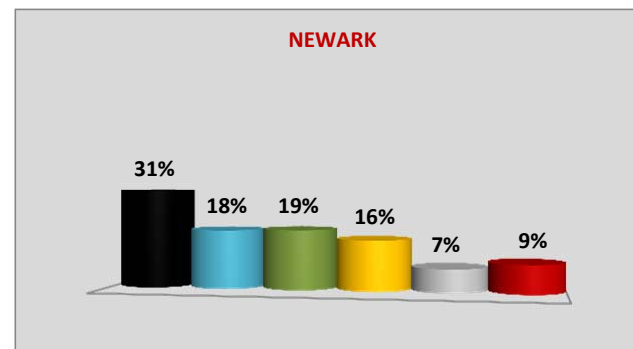
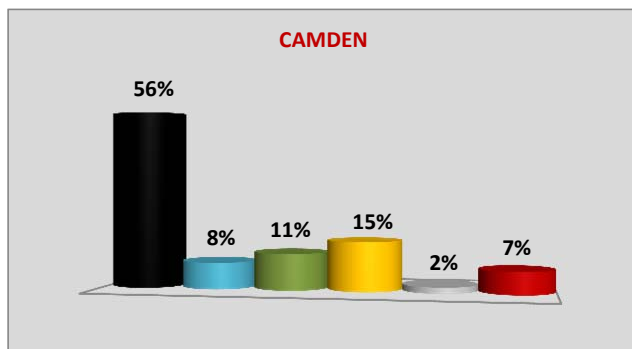

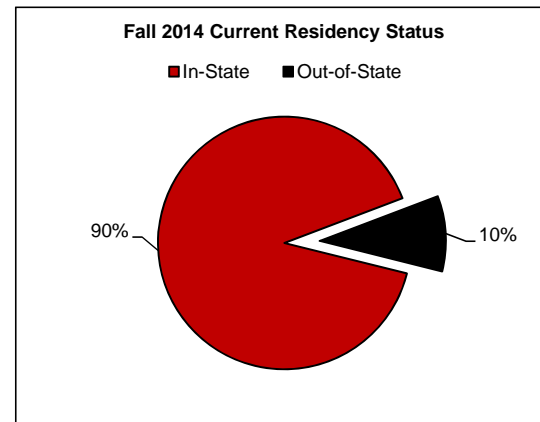

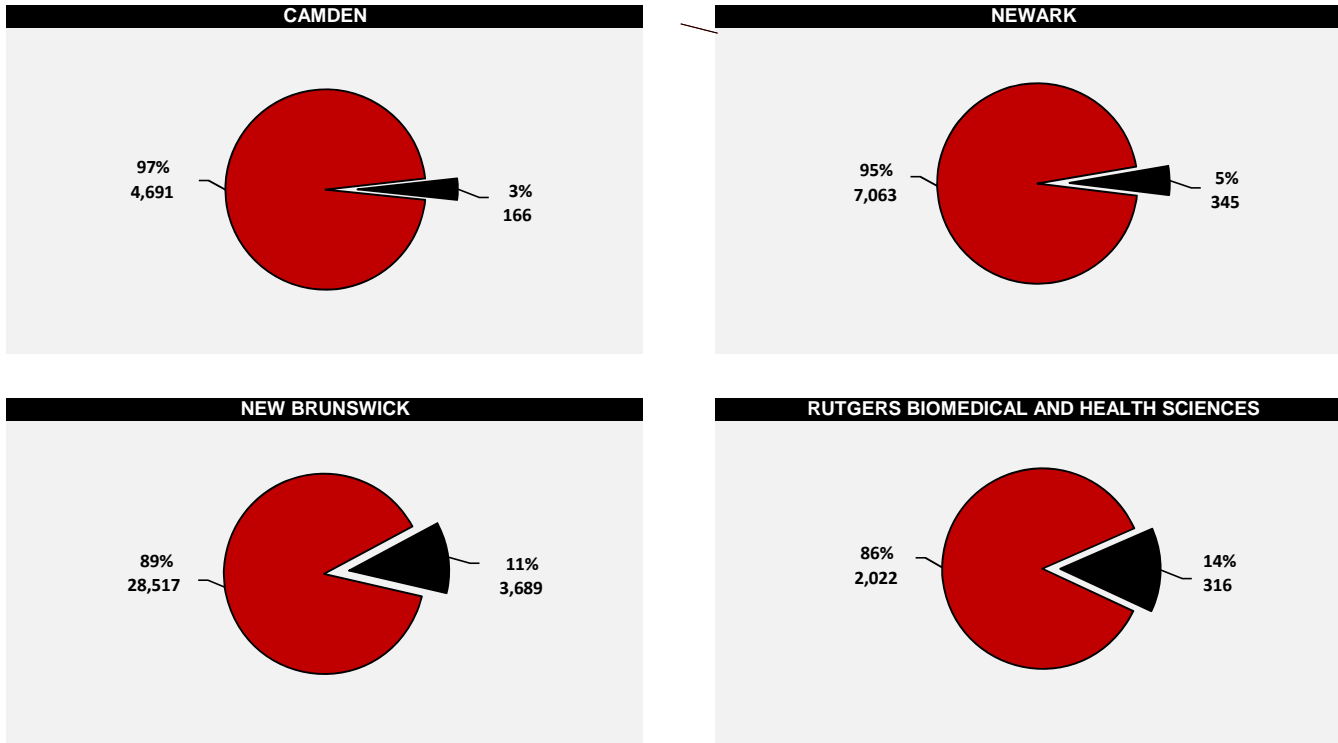

■ In-State ■ Out-of-State



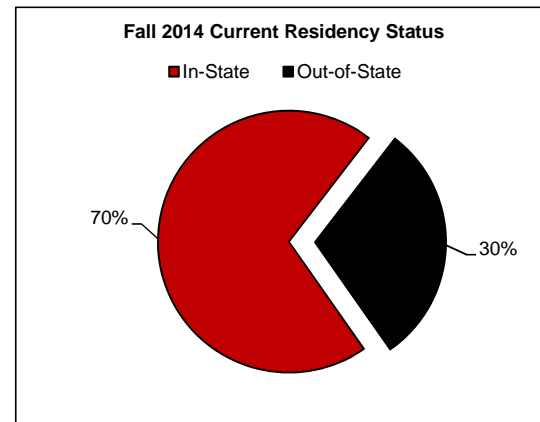

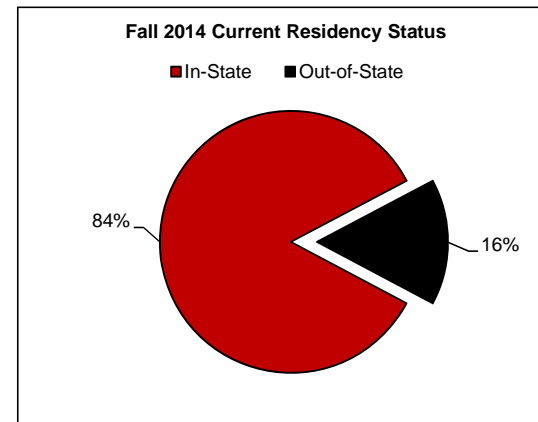

■ In-State ■ Out-of-State



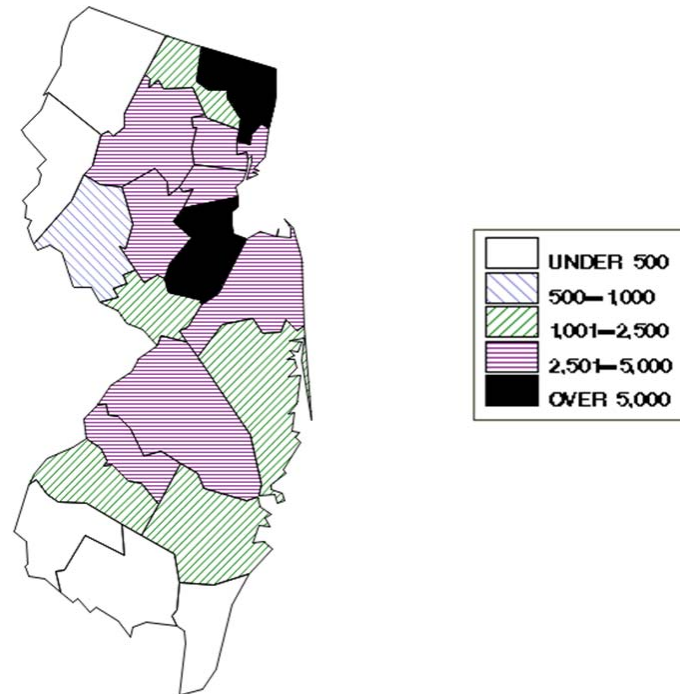

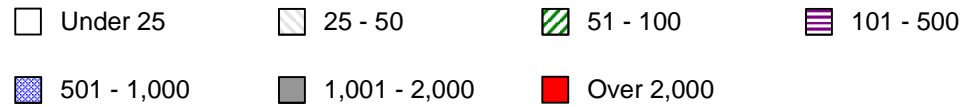

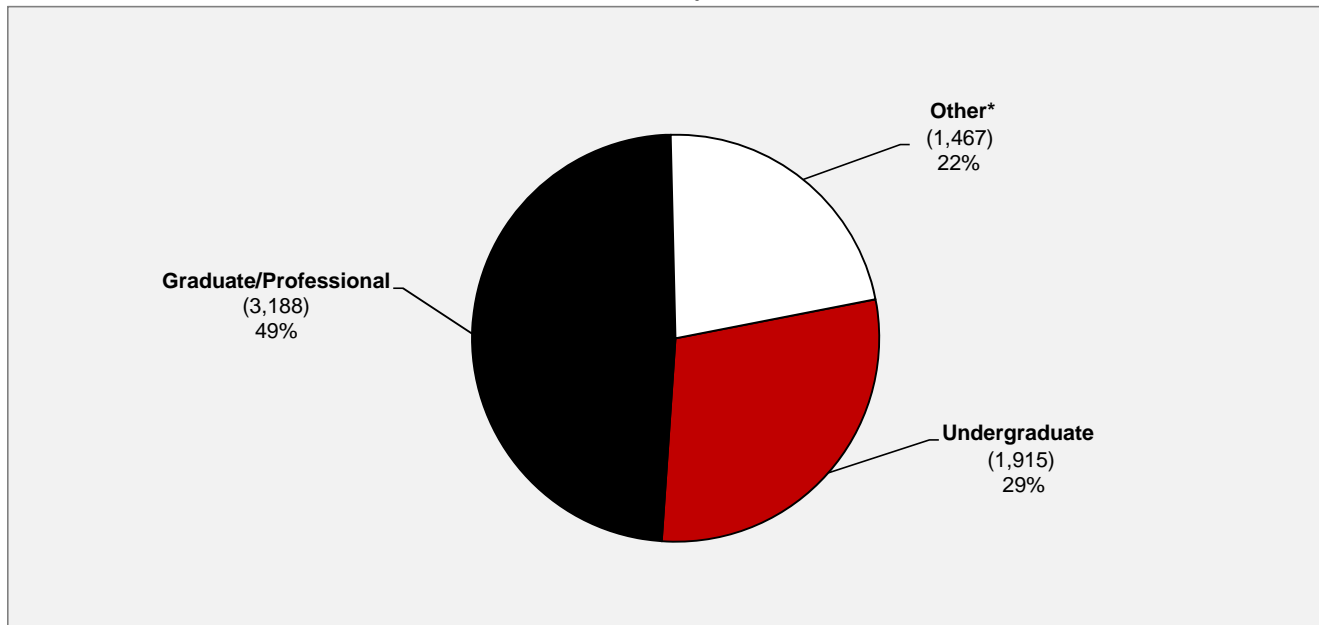
**Map of Enrollment Headcount by Original State - Total University**
